Many thanks for your comments and suggestions regarding my Annual Report which was presented to the Police and Crime Panel on 25 July 2018.

I am more than happy to provide further clarity on the Year in a Nutshell section relating to the month of October and the new law of criminal convictions of sexual abuse victims. Likewise I will also include more information on the funding formula campaign and the actions I have taken in this regard.

There were numerous other comments within your response which I am happy to note and take into consideration in my future work. Having said that, I am afraid that in respect of the Troubled Families Programme, whilst I provide funding, it would be difficult for me to provide an indication of the full impact of the programmes that are in place as these are delivered by local authorities.

The Panel have raised the issue of my Police and Crime Plan having no numerical targets or key performance indicators. This is an issue which I am prepared to consider over the next 12 months and whilst I am not a fan of such measures I do recognise the Panel would benefit from some measures being in place to assist them in judging the achievement of my Plan.

Finally, my thanks to you and the Panel members for their kind comments on my Annual Report and the recognition of the hard work that has been undertaken to date.
