

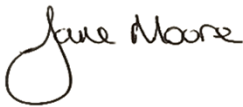

"This County Council condemns the government's proposal for local government reorganisation in Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland.

Their proposal to drag 100,000s of county residents into Leicester City, overwhelmingly against their will, is an undemocratic disgrace.

Council notes that the Liberal Democrat group opposes the government's proposal to put the rest of Leicestershire and Rutland into one Unitary authority, believing such an authority will be too remote from many residents.
