

Mountsorrel Library Profile

September 2015

Mountsorrel Library

At the time of the 2011 Census, the population of the Mountsorrel library catchment* was 15,976; of which, 15,289 (96 percent) were white and 687 (4 percent) were non-white. There were 3,414 residents under the age of 18 (21 percent), and 2,659 residents aged 65 and over (17 percent). Areas within the catchment with high numbers of 65+ residents were located in an around the Walton Way area of Mountsorrel, peripheral parts of Rothley and in Cossington.

The table below shows the complete population breakdown of the catchment by age;

There were 2,616 people (20 percent) of working age in the area with no qualifications, 3,813 (29 percent) with Level 1 or 2 qualifications and 5,406 (42 percent) with Level 3 qualifications or above. There were 8,806 economically active people of working age in the library catchment; of which 362 were unemployed and 317 were full-time students.

In 2011, there were 1,877 single person households in the catchment, 640 households aged 65 and over, and 637 lone parent households. Of the 4,839 families in the area, 2,808 (58 percent) had no dependent children, 935 (19 percent) had one dependent child, 828 (17 percent) had two dependent children while 268 (6 percent) had three or more dependent children. In total, there were 3,482 dependent children in the library catchment. There were 48 households (1 percent) in the library catchment where no member of the household spoke English as a main language.

Of the 6,765 households in the area, 3,585 (53 percent) were not deprived in any dimension, 2,058 (30 percent) were deprived in one dimension and 1,122 (17 percent) were deprived in two or more dimensions. These areas were located in and around the central parts of Mountsorrel, Woodfield Road and Babington Roads in Rothley, Barrow Road in Sileby and Sileby Road in Barrow. LSOAs covering the centre of Mountsorrel and the North Western

part of Sileby fall within the top 10 percent most deprived LSOAs in Leicestershire.

There were 976 people (6 percent) in the library catchment whose day to day activities were limited a lot, 1,937 (9 percent) whose activities were limited a little and 13,603 (85) whose activities were not limited. There were 902 households (13 percent) without access to a car or van in 2011, 2,766 (41 percent) with access to one car or van while 3,097 households (46 percent) had access to more than one car or van. Areas with higher numbers of households without access to a car or van were located in and around the central parts of each village in the catchment area while areas with higher numbers of multi-vehicle households could be found in more peripheral of the catchment, such as Rothley Plain and Cossington.

There were 20 communal establishments in the area in 2011, housing 167 people. There are currently 295 dwellings with outline planning permission in the library catchment, 54 with detailed planning permission and fifteen dwellings under construction. There is currently a large development of 250 dwellings with planning permission in between Rothley and Mountsorrel, along Mountsorrel Lane. Elsewhere, there are smaller developments with planning permission in the centre and southern edge of Rothley, the centre of Mountsorrel, and the western edge of Sileby. In addition, the fifteen dwellings under construction are located around Linkfield Road in Mountsorrel.

*The catchment is defined as the area covered by census output areas containing 80 percent of the library borrowers, by distance to the output area population centroid.

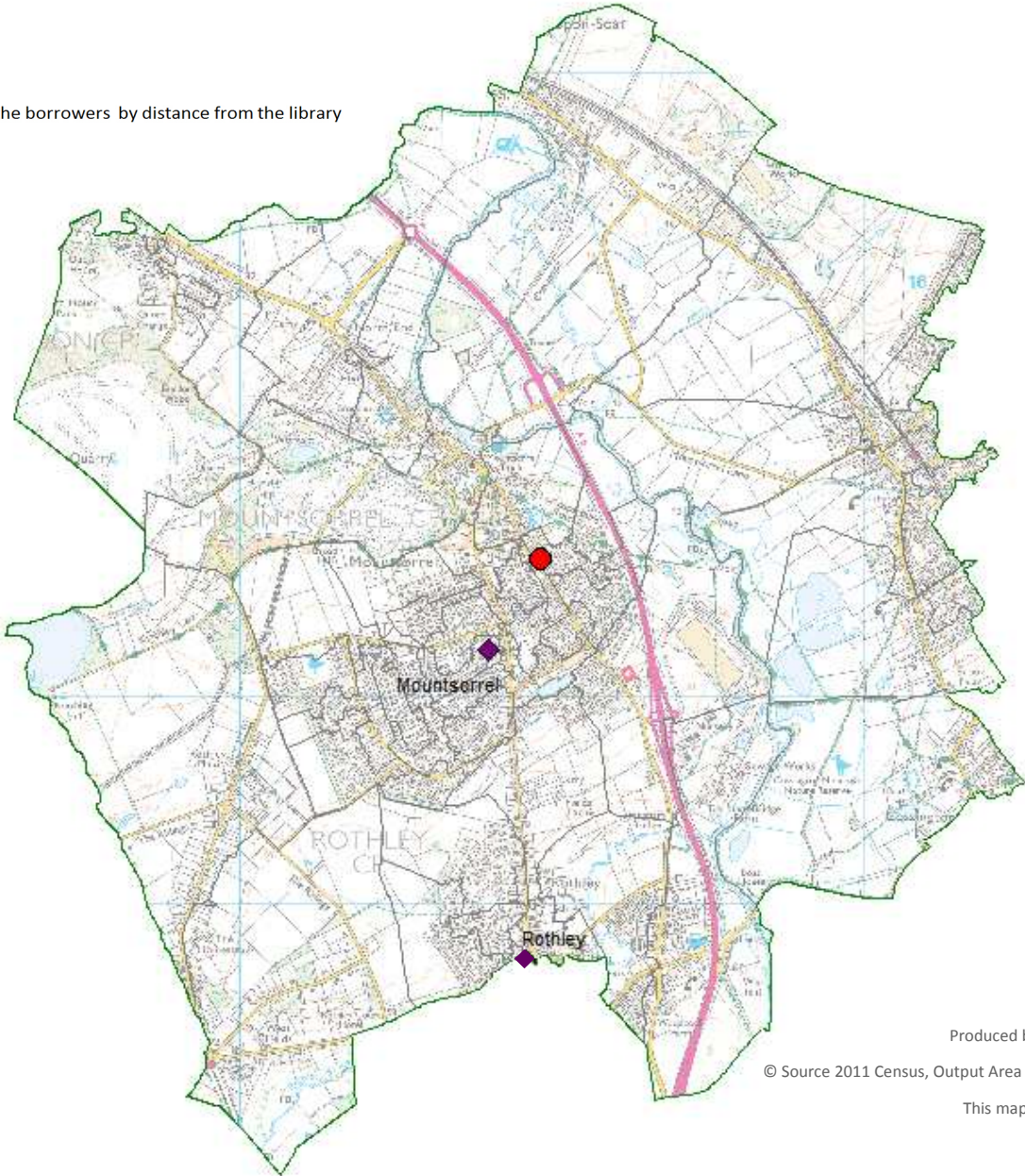

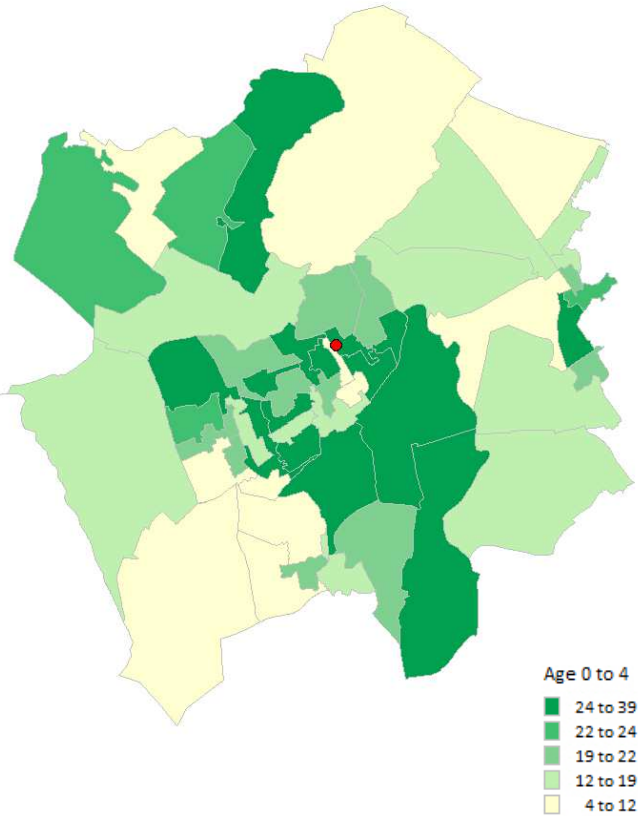

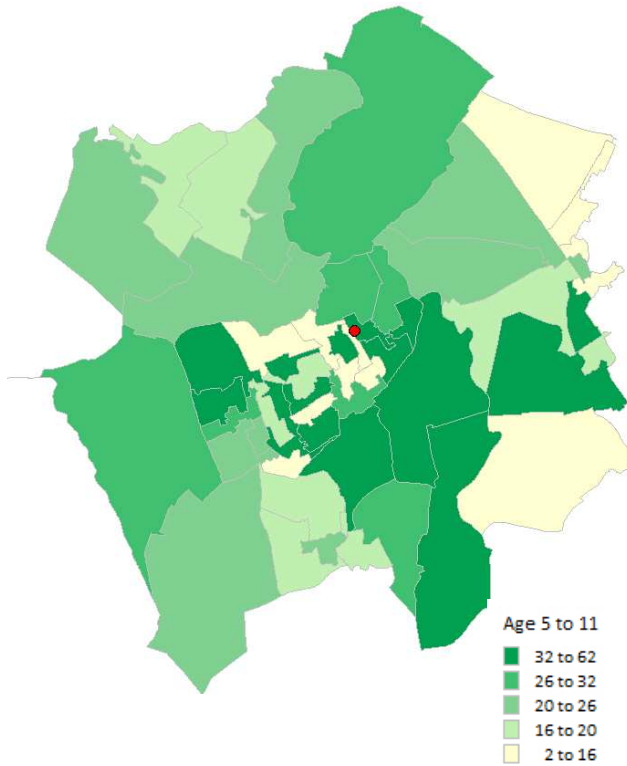

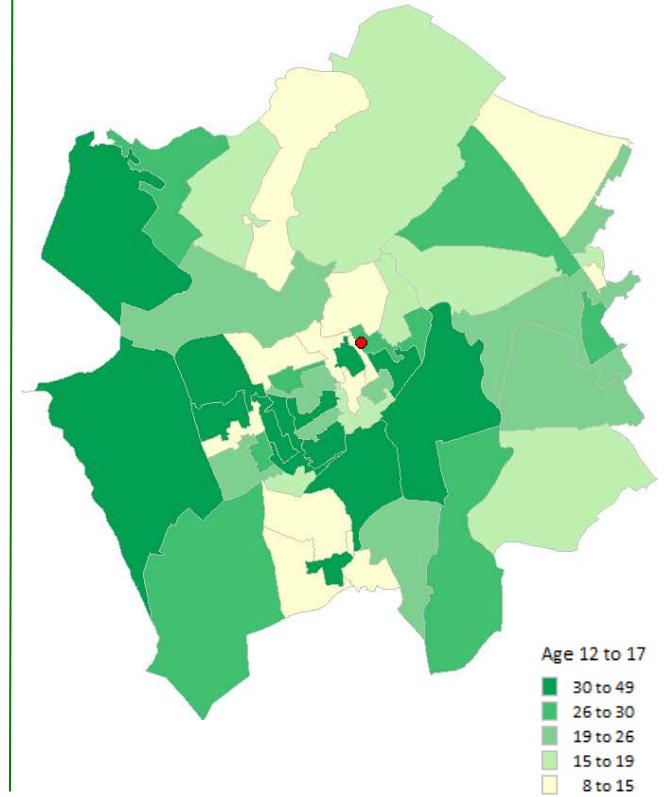

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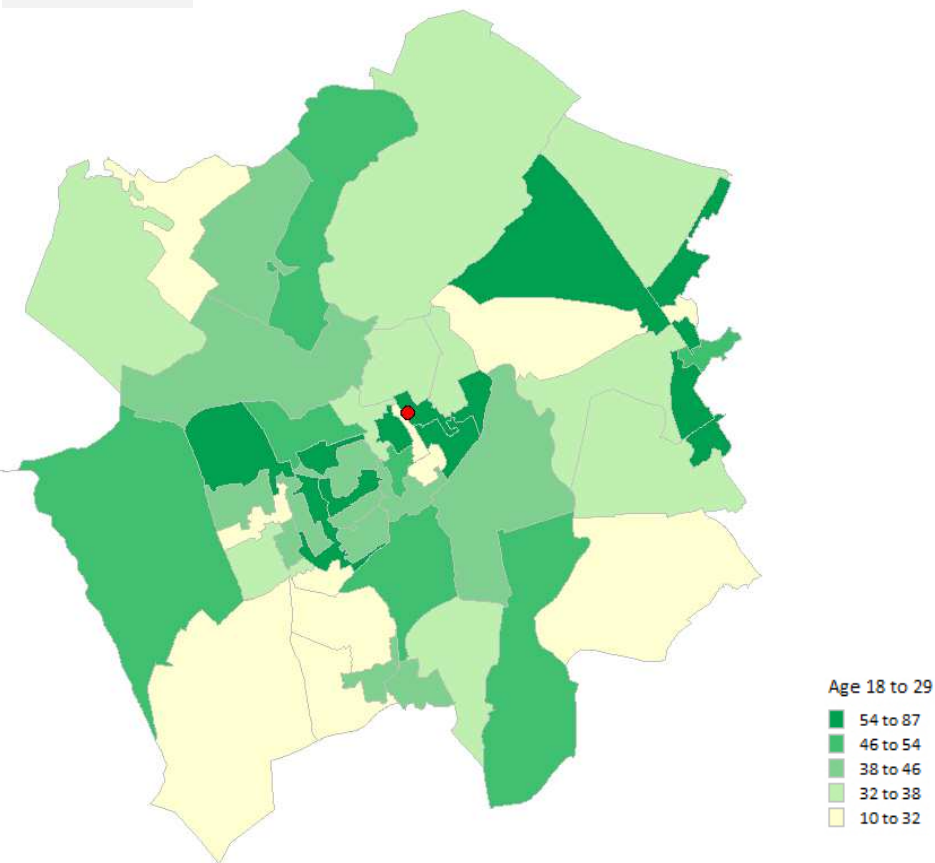

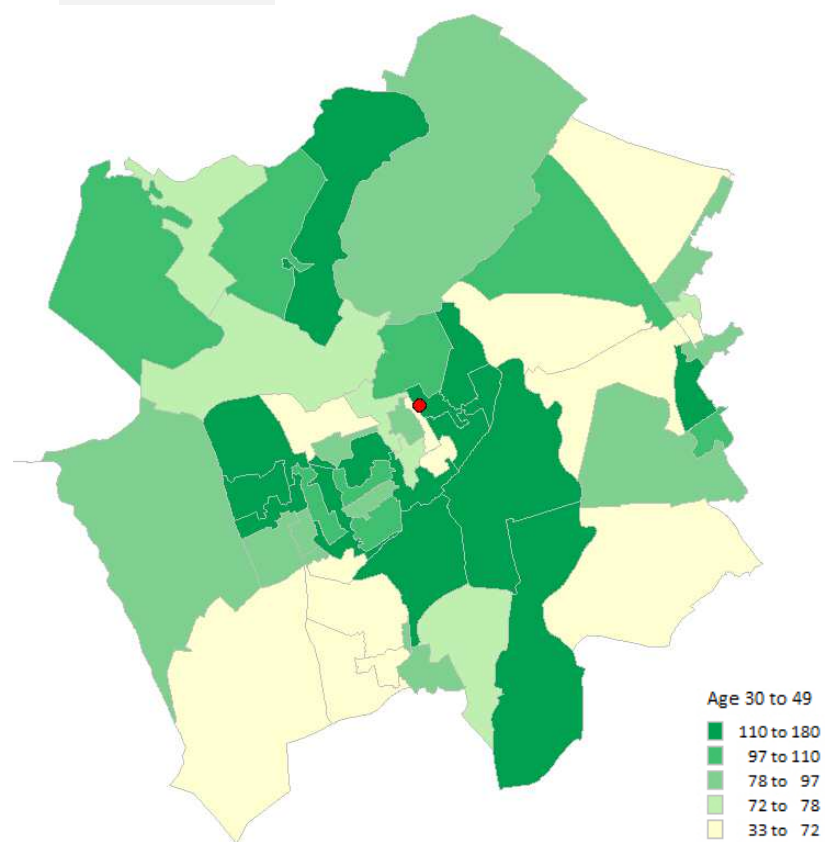

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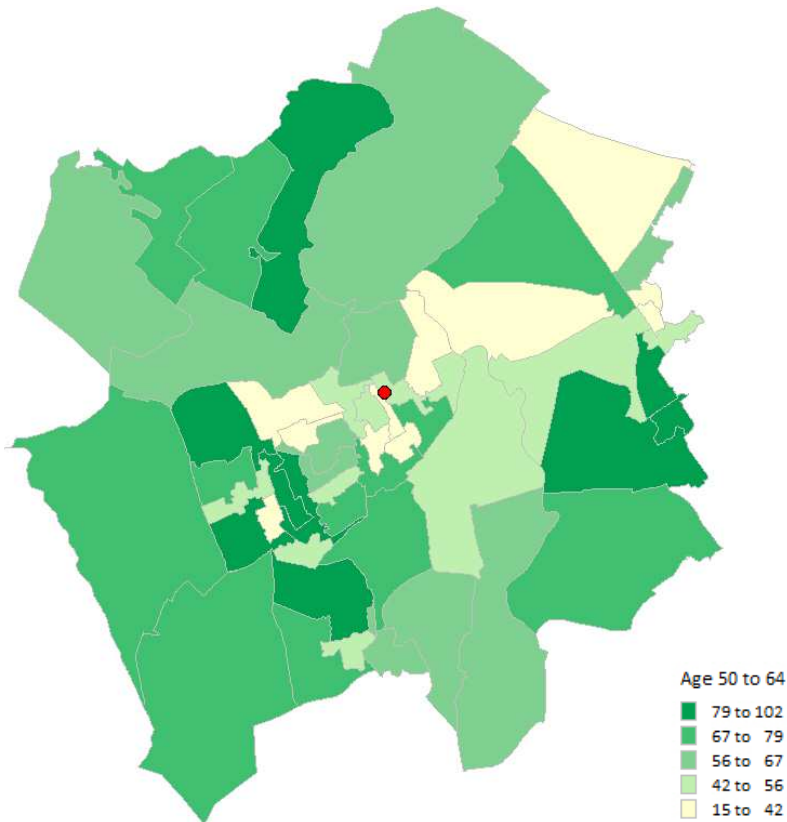

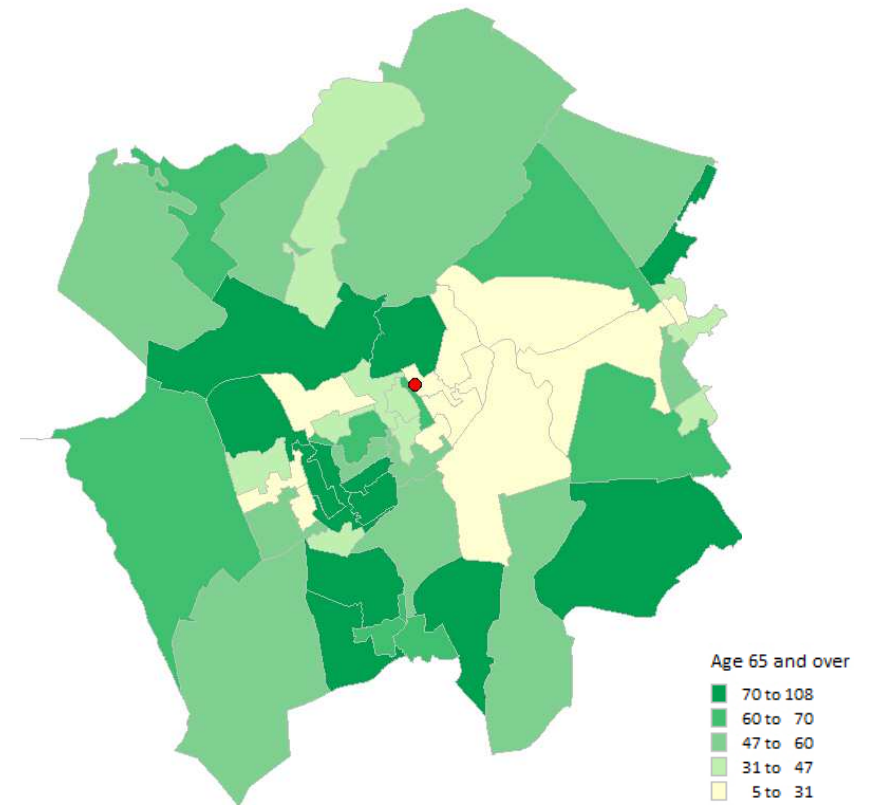

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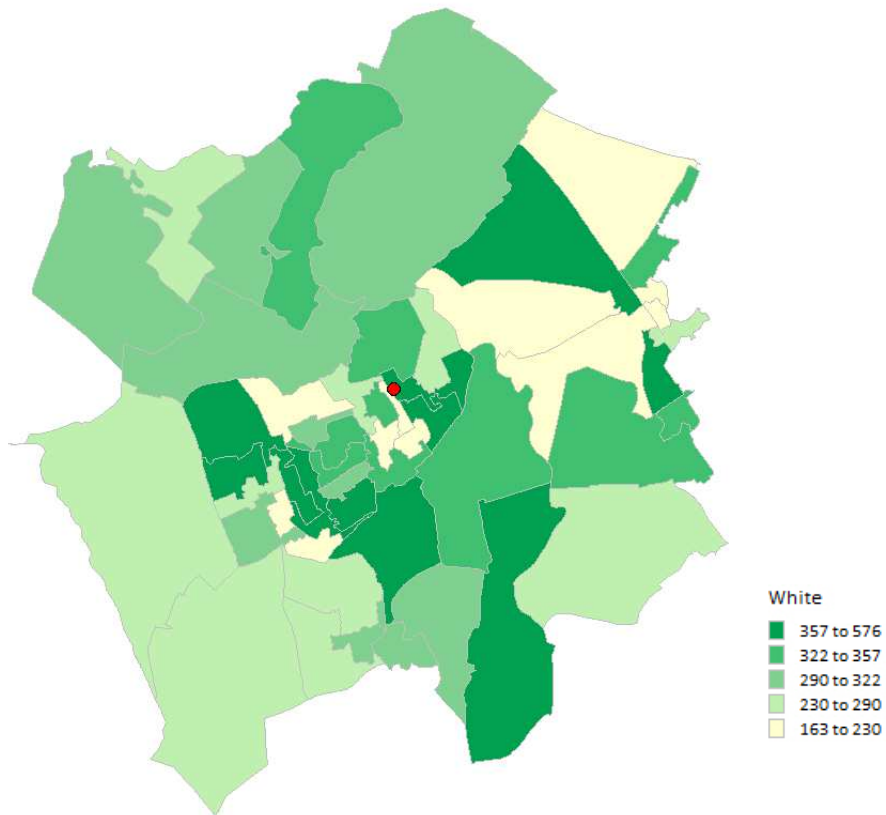

Ethnic Group - Non - White

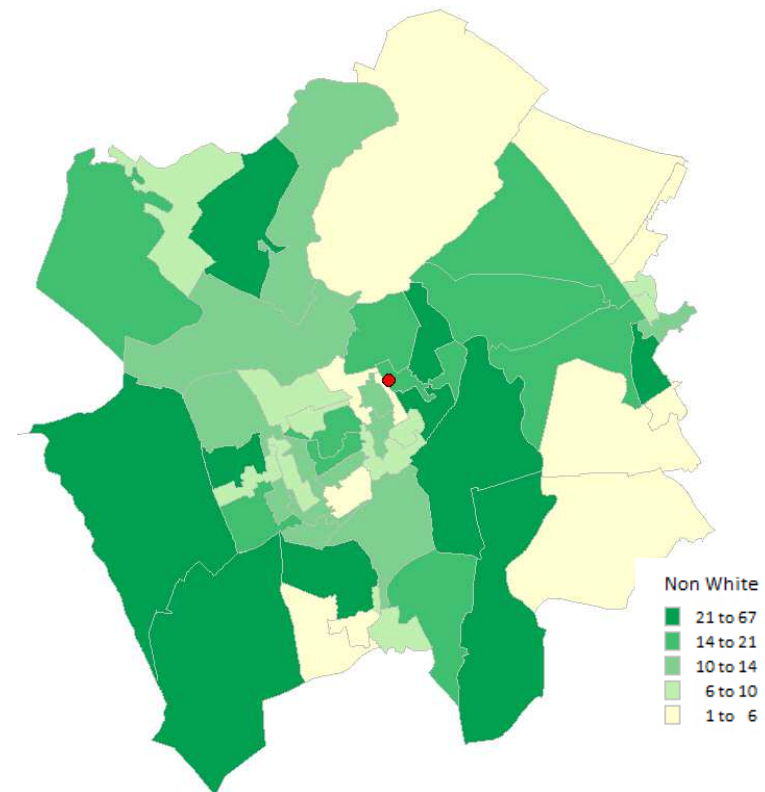

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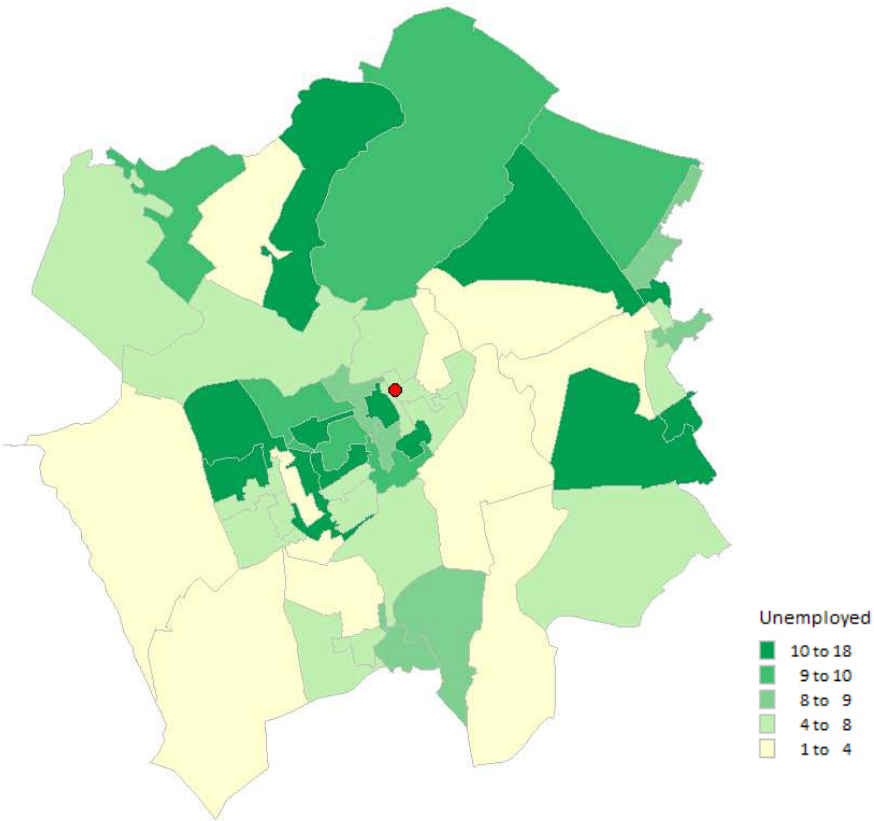

Economically Active - Full-time Students

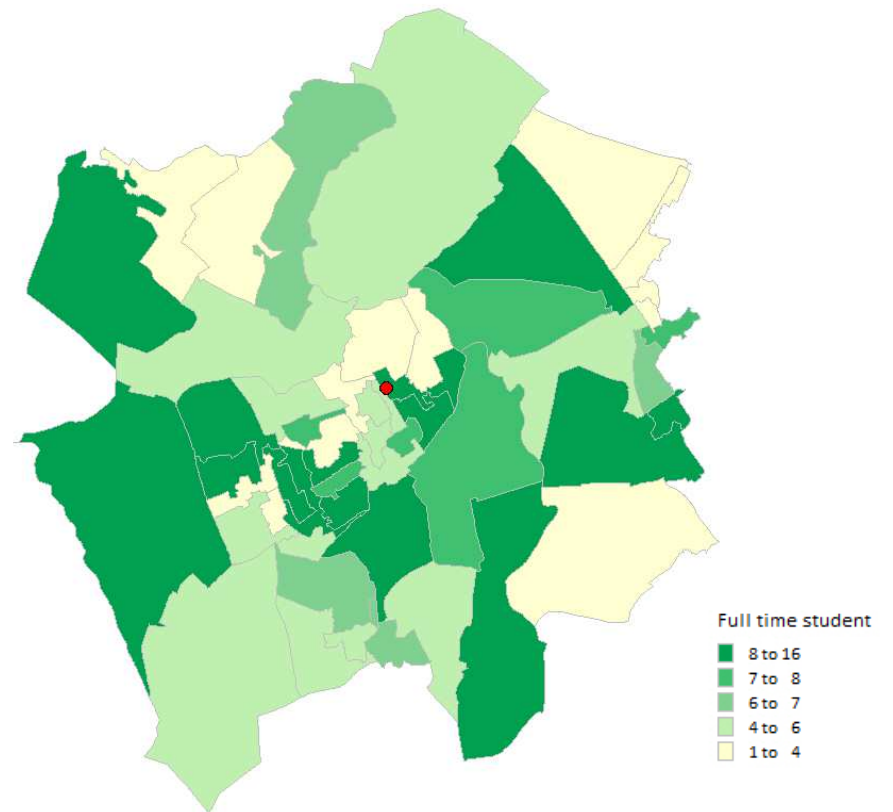

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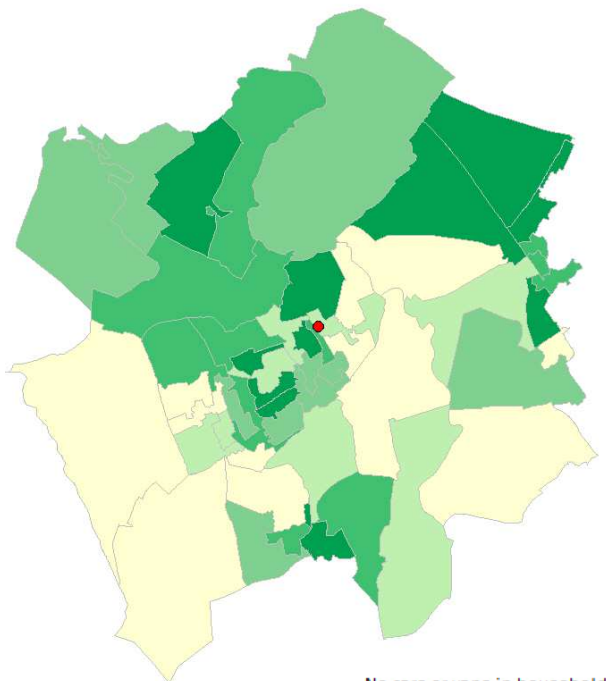

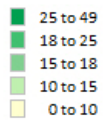

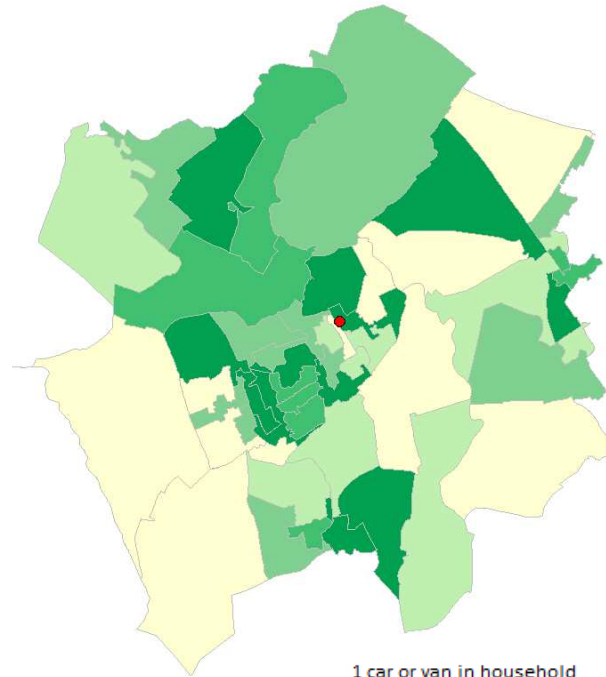

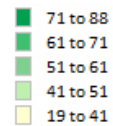

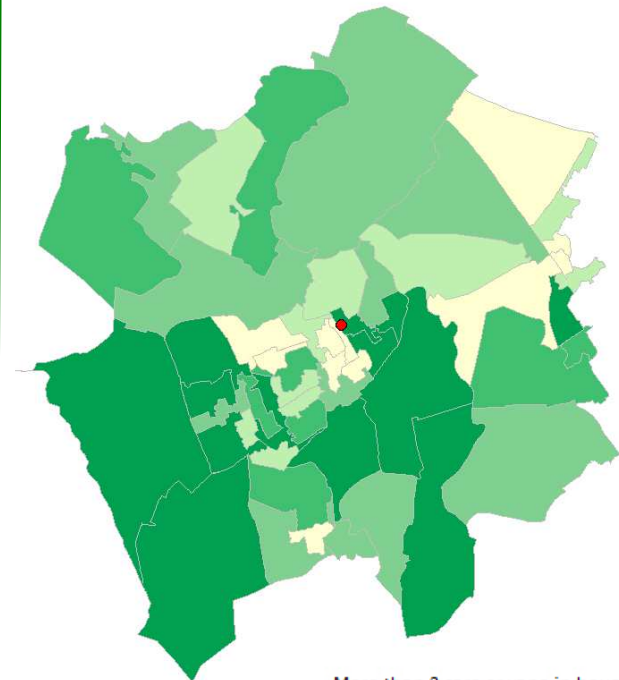

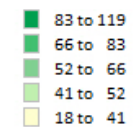

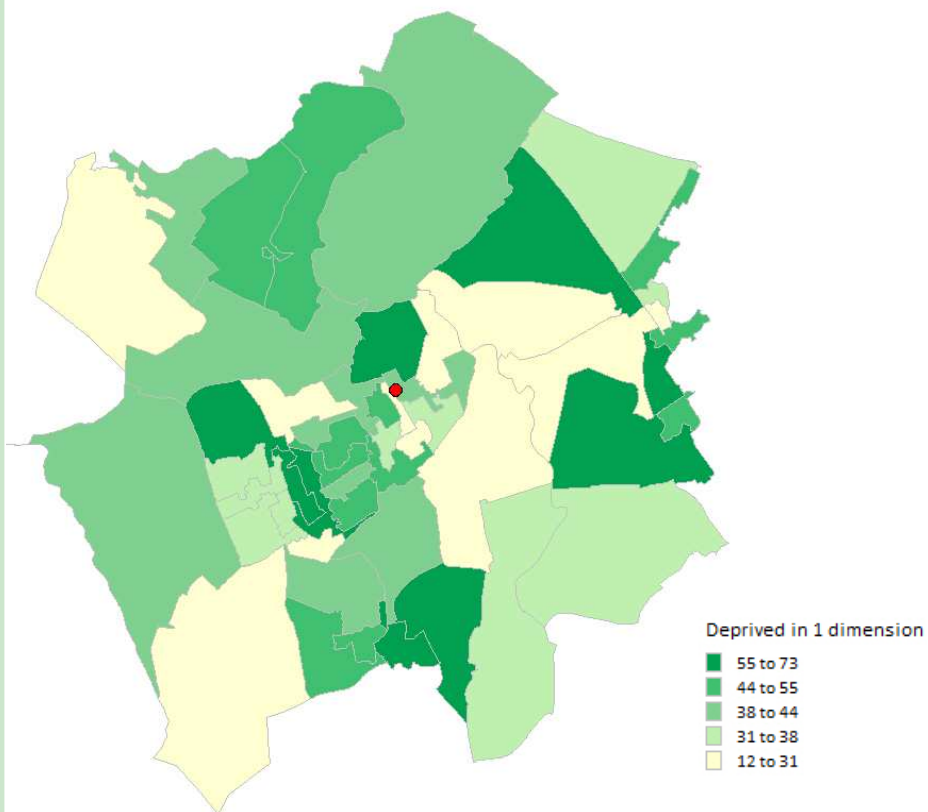

Households deprived in more than 2 dimensions

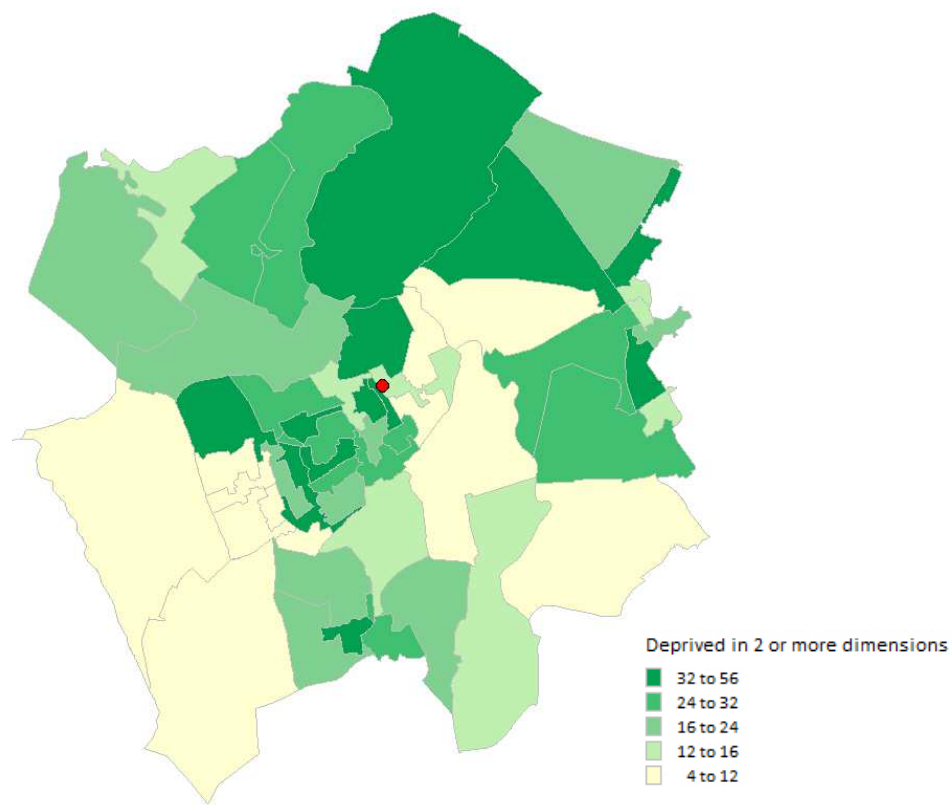

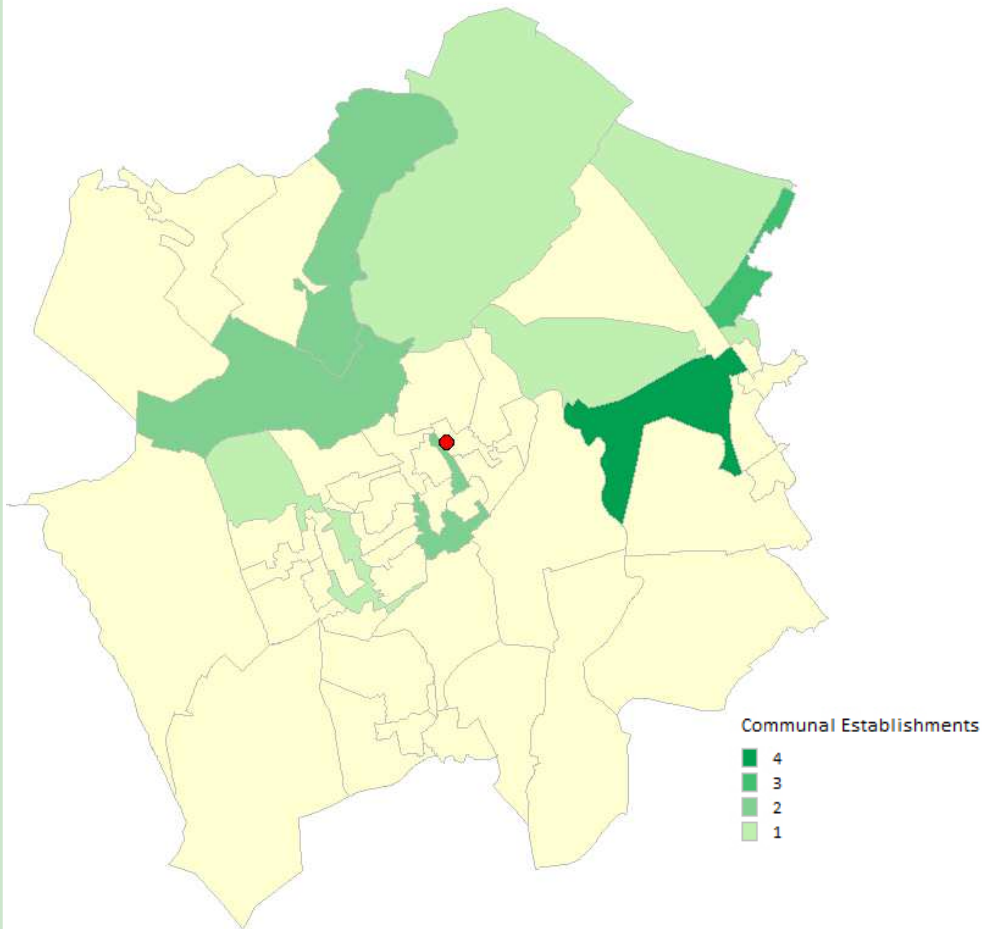

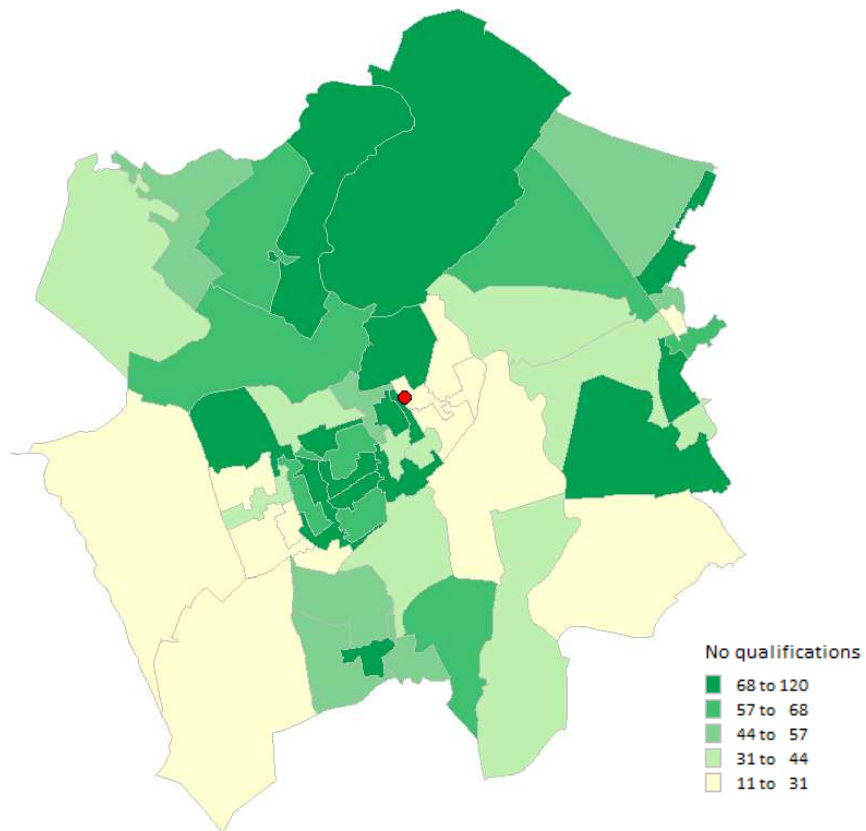

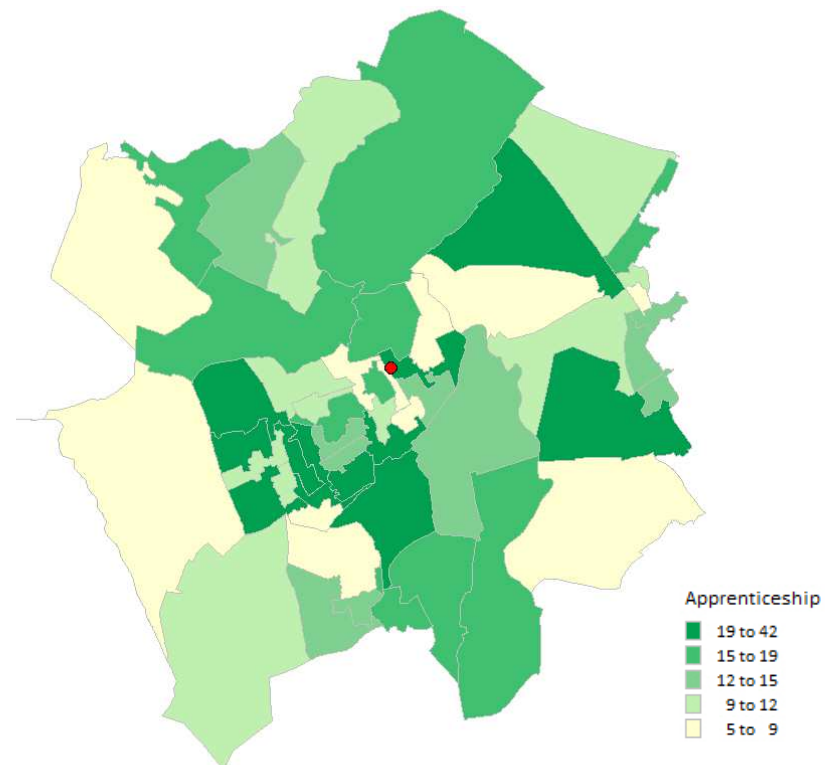

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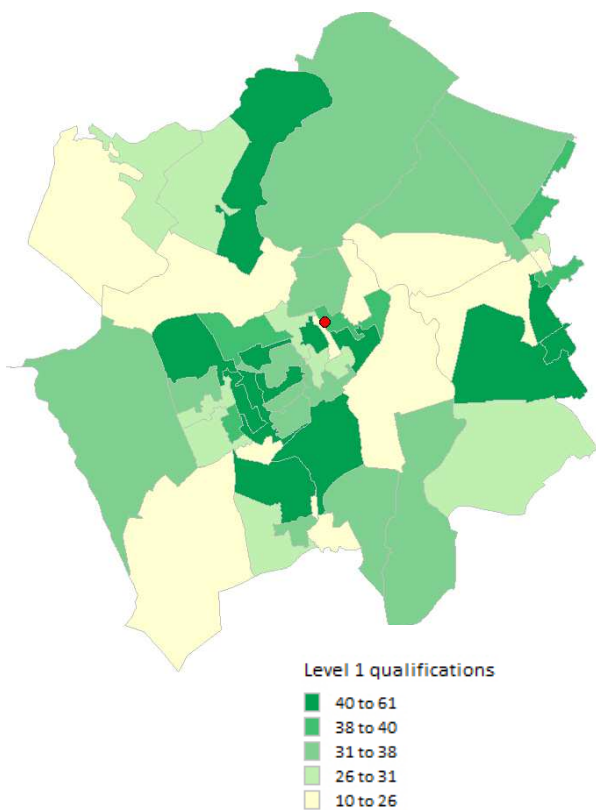

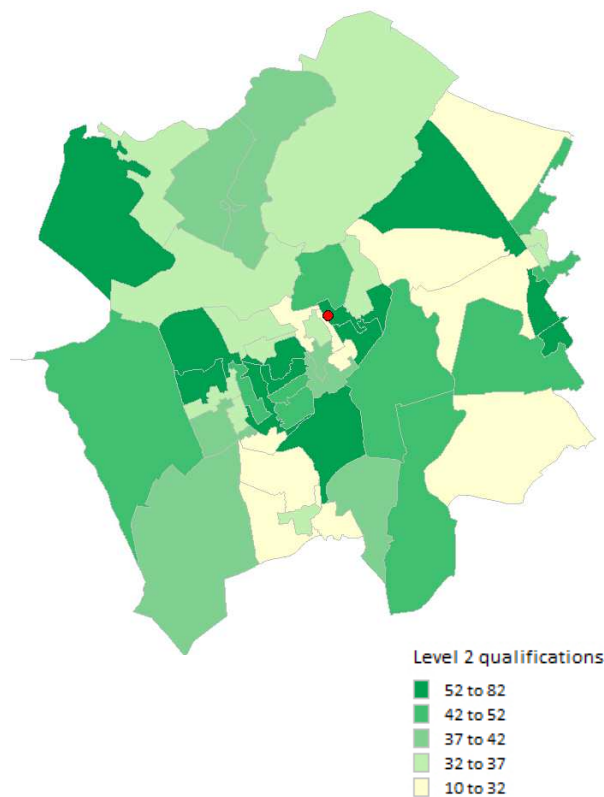

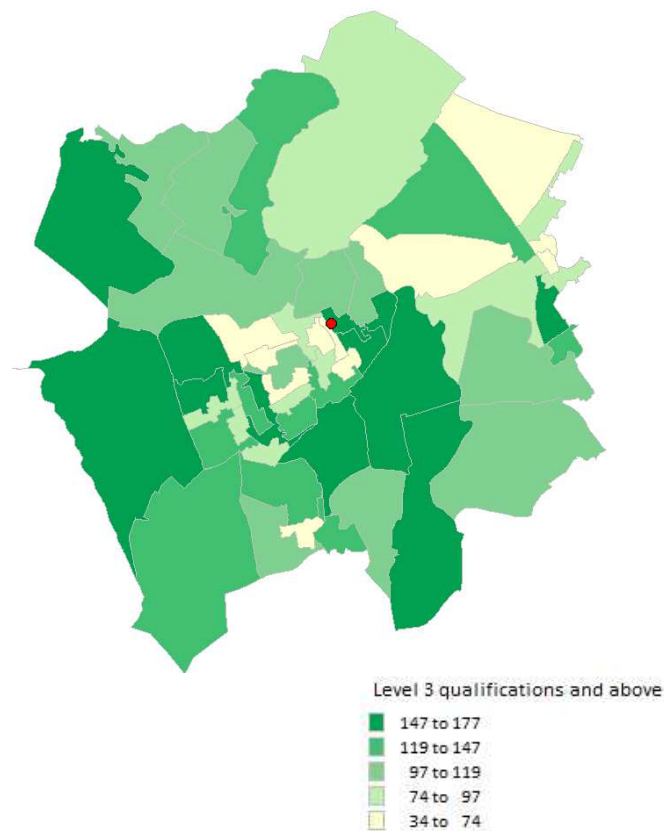

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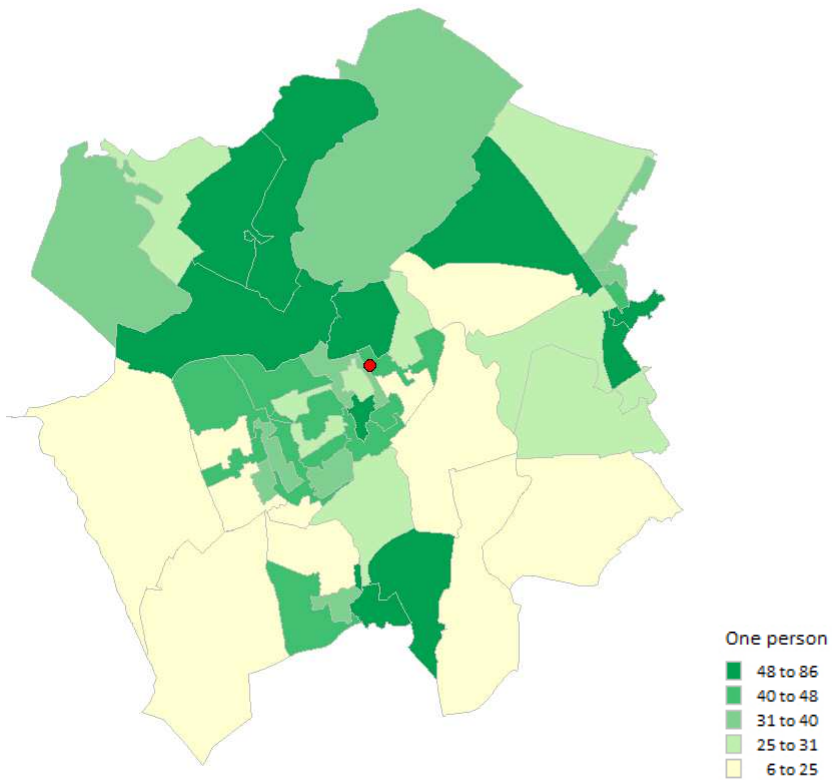

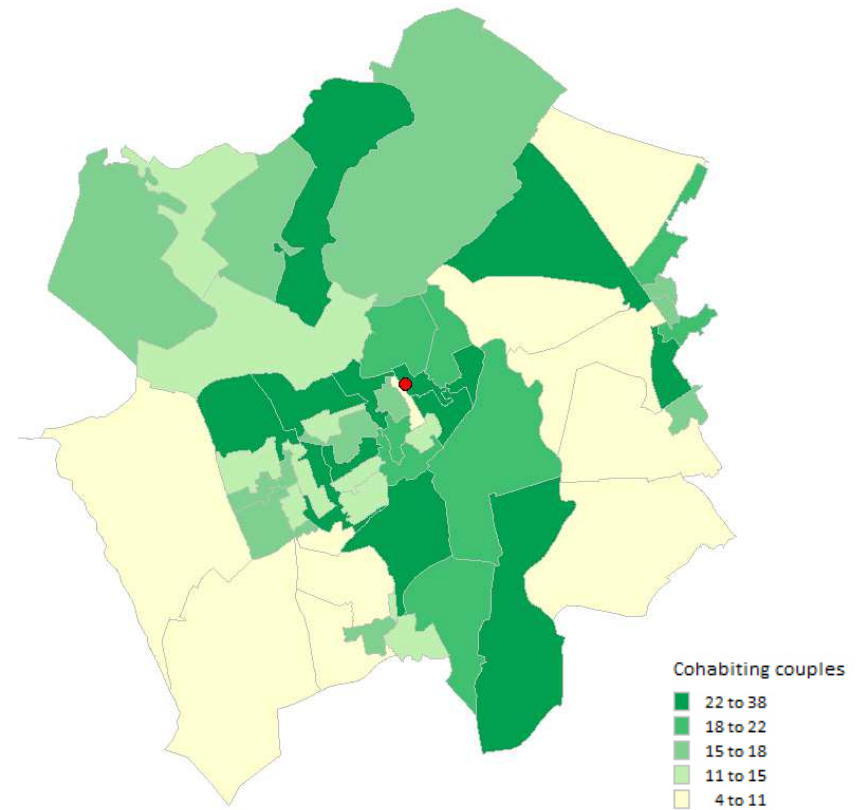

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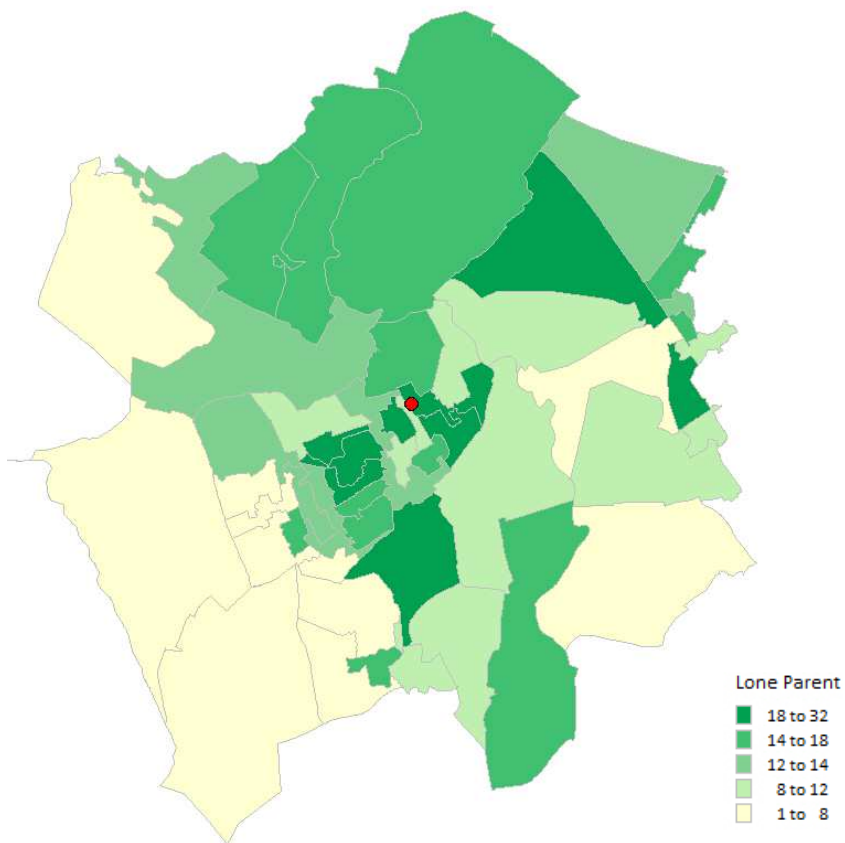

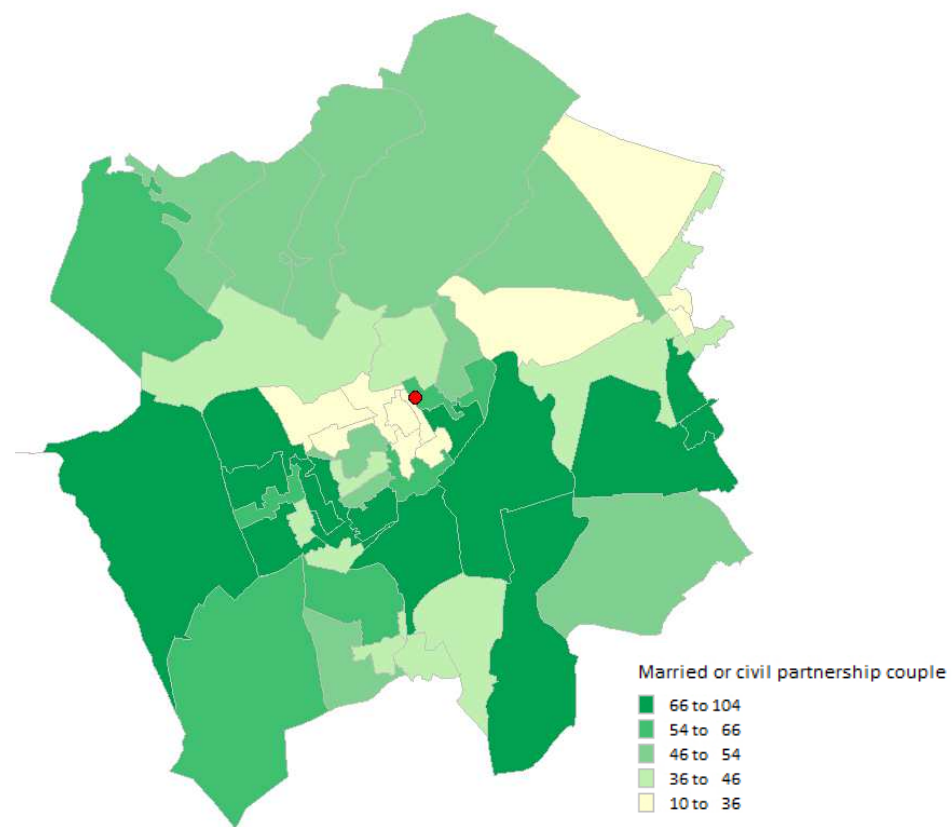

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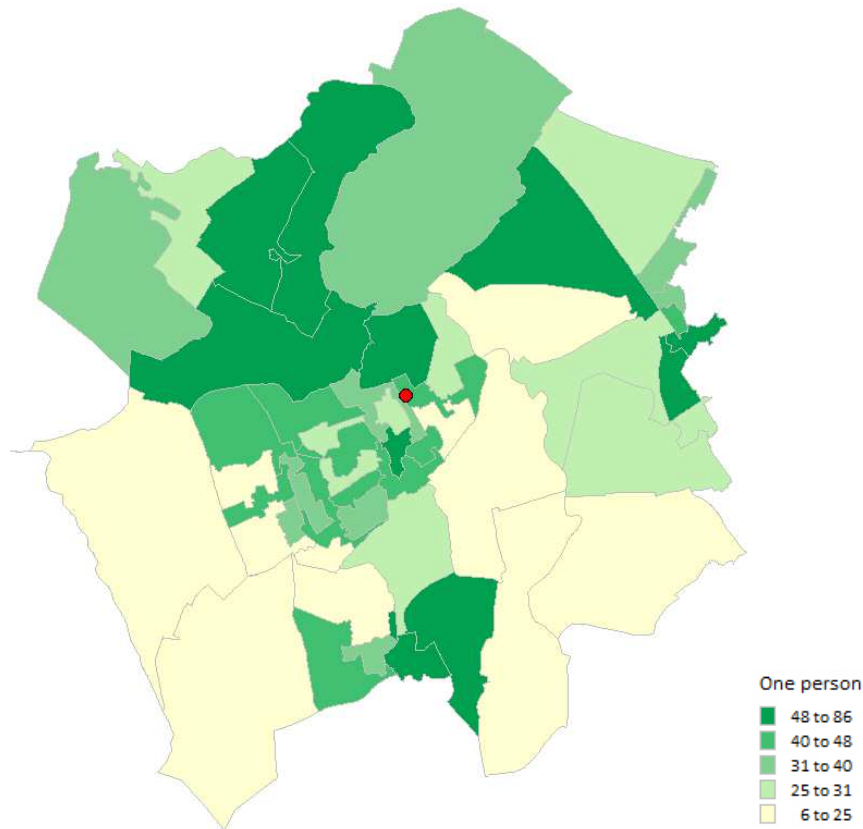

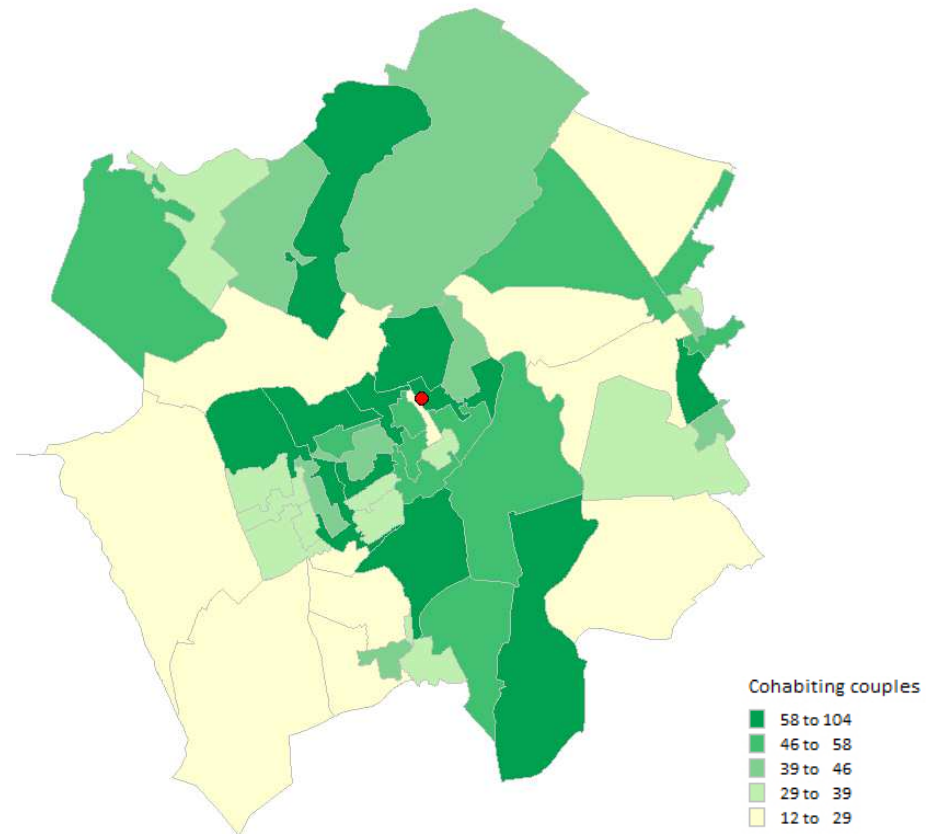

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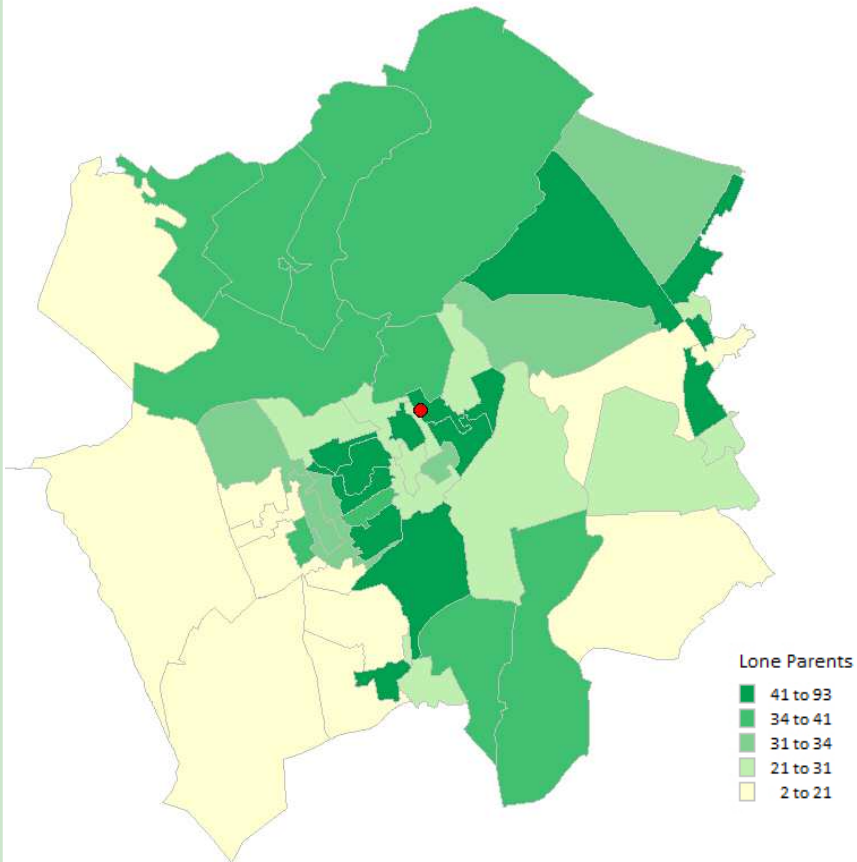

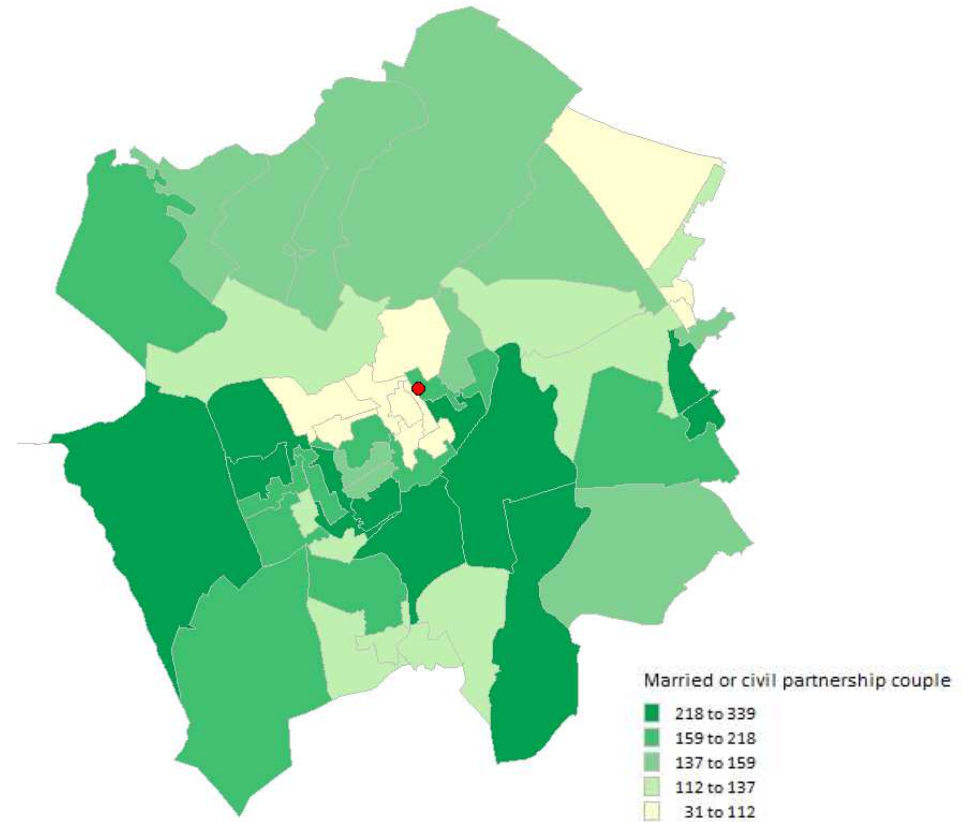

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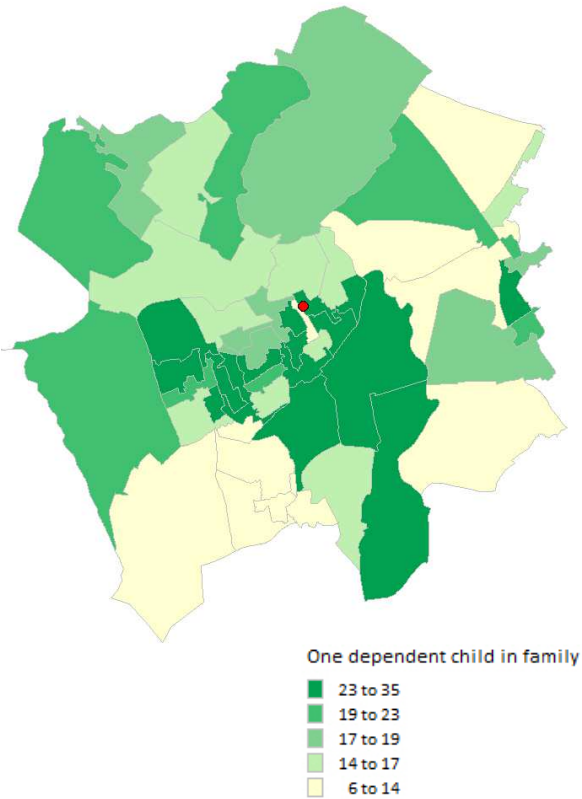

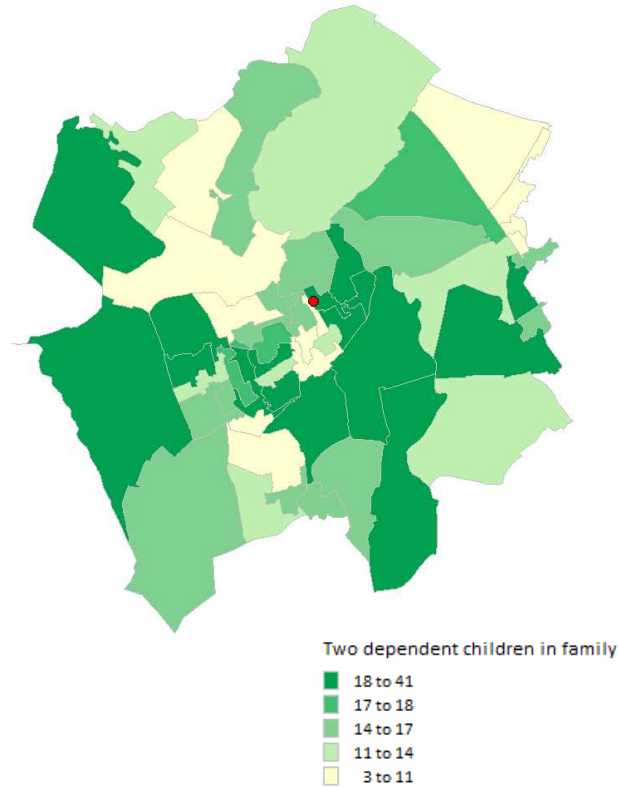
Number of households - Families with dependent children

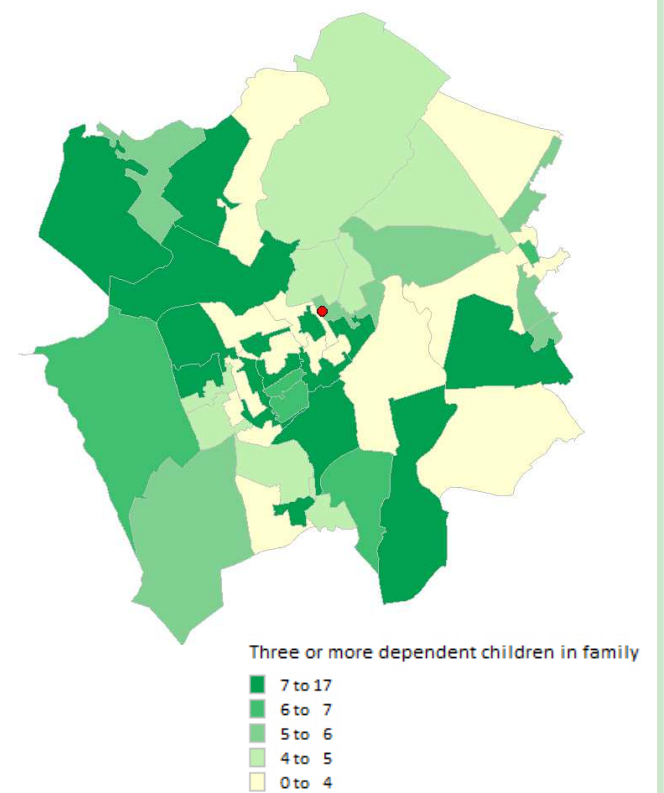
One dependent child in family

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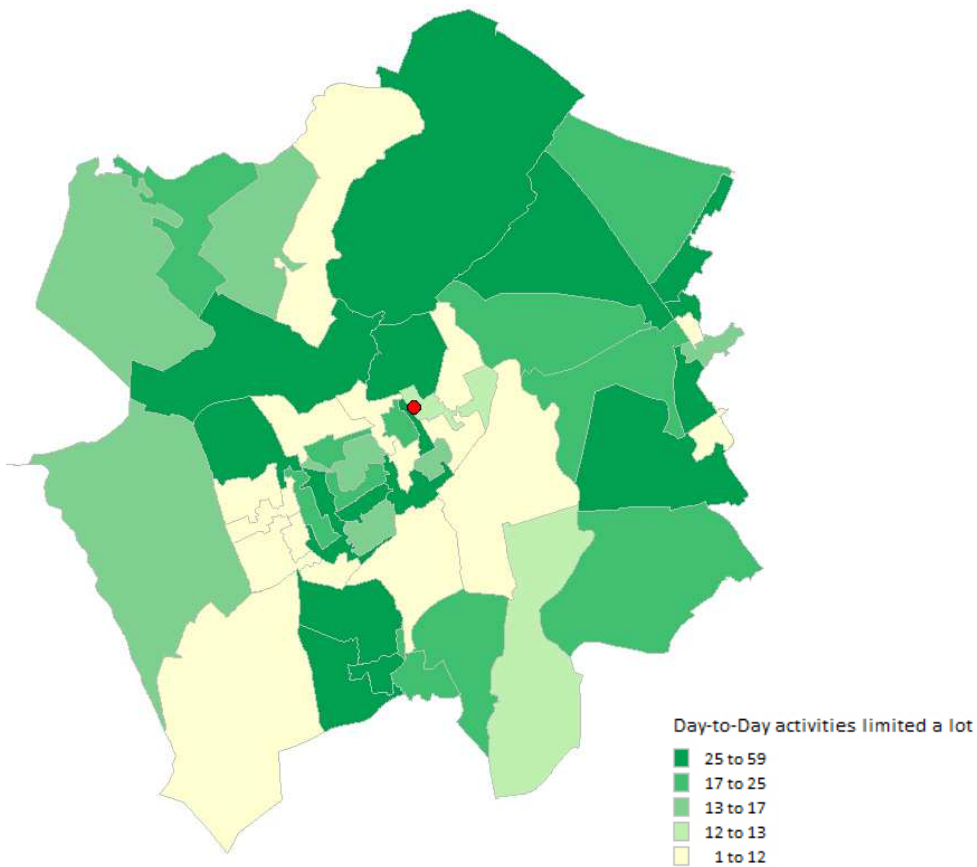

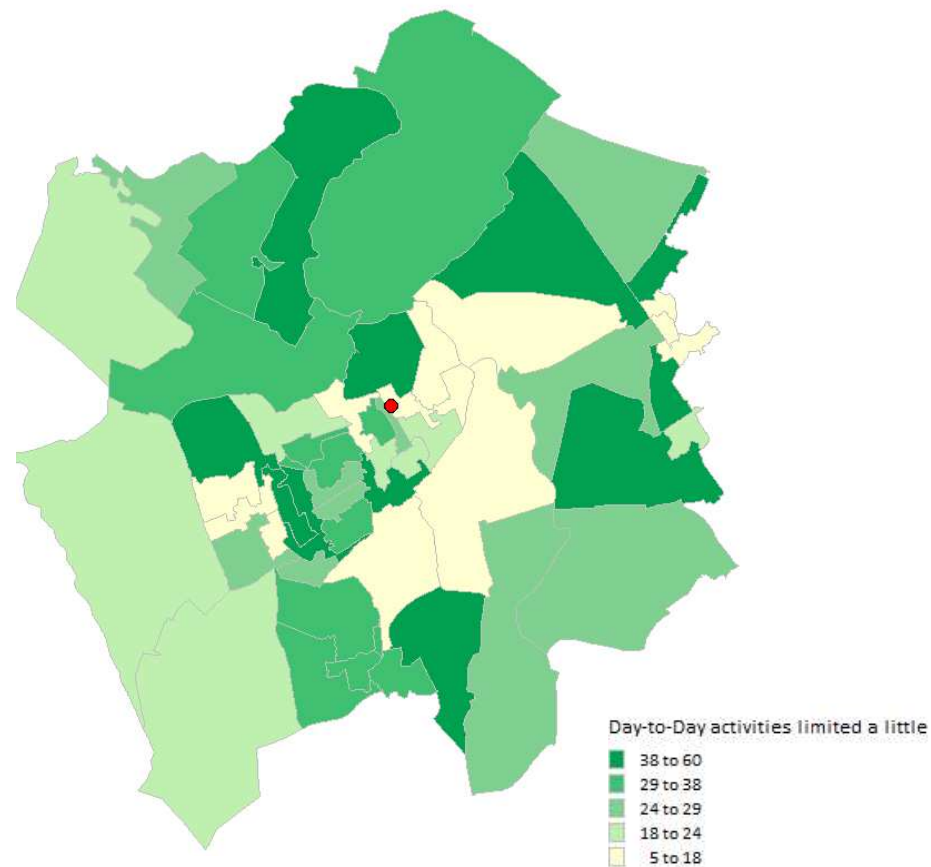

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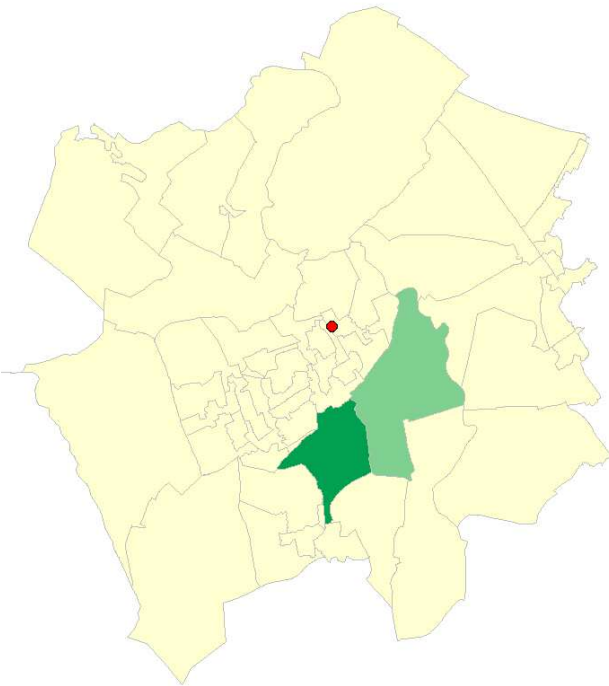

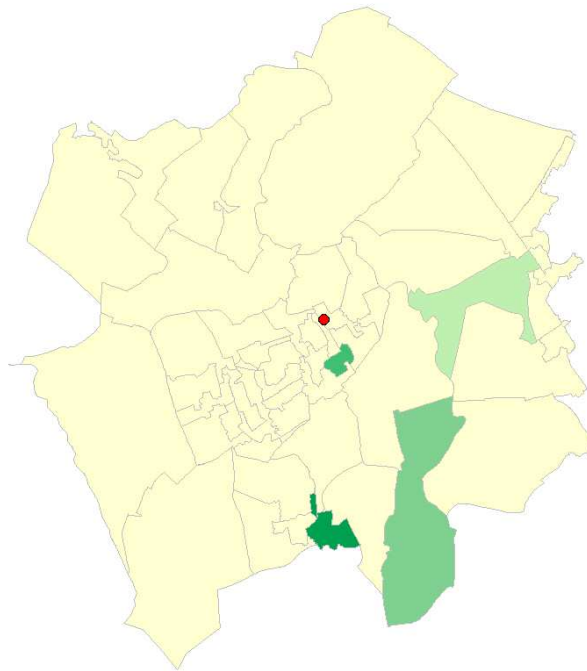

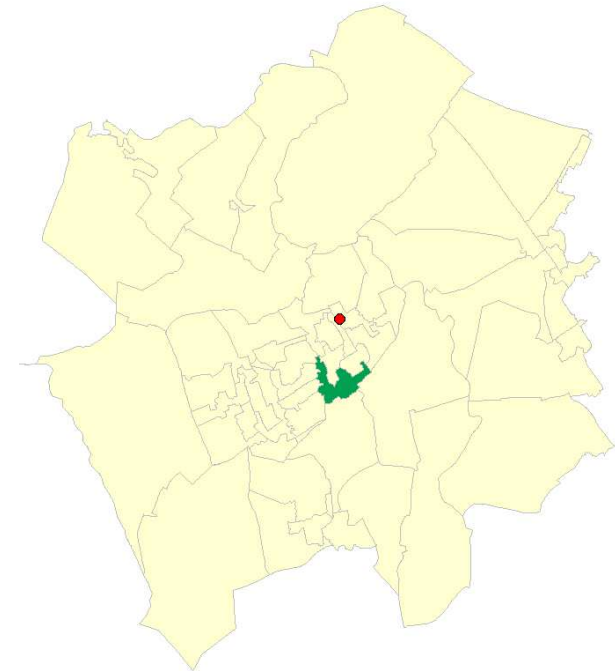
