**Purpose of Report**

1. For the Chief Executive to present the final Annual Report of Sir Clive Loader, Police and Crime Commissioner.

**Recommendations**

2. To note the 2015/16 Annual Report of Sir Clive Loader Police and Crime Commissioner for the period November 2012 - May 2016.

**Context**

3. The Annual Report for 2015/16 is the third and final full year's Annual Report of Sir Clive Loader, who held the post of Police and Crime Commissioner for the period November 2012 - March 2016.
4. Although the tenure of Sir Clive Loader, as Police and Crime Commissioner, has now completed, there is still a requirement to produce an Annual Report for the third and final year of his tenure to the Police and Crime Panel. The Annual report outlines progress against his Police and Crime Plan 2013-2017.
5. The Annual Report contains updates in respect of the Performance and other key areas presented to and discussed at the Panel during 2015/16.
6. A draft of the Annual Report was prepared on behalf of Sir Clive before leaving office and this was discussed and reviewed with the Force and Chief Officers in the OPCC.
7. The report is being submitted to the Police and Crime Panel by the Chief Executive in the context outlined above.
8. The Panel are advised that the Annual Report for 2016/17 will be produced by the current Police and Crime Commissioner The Right Honourable Willy Baron Bach in line with his priorities, his Police and Crime Plan and his preferred approach. It is envisaged that this will be considered by the Panel in June/July 2017.

**Implications**

Legal: There is a legal requirement for a PCC to provide an Annual report to the Police and Crime Panel.
