APPOINTMENT OF INDEPENDENT MEMBERS TO THE STANDARDS COMMITTEE

REPORT OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE

Purpose

1. The purpose of this report is to seek the Committee's approval of the proposed timetable for the appointment of independent members to the Standards Committee.

Background

- 2. The terms of reference of the Constitution Committee include the function of advertising and interviewing suitable people for recommendation to the County Council for appointment as an independent member of the Standards Committee.
- 3. The Relevant Authorities (Standards Committees) Regulations 2001 require that where a Standards Committee has more than three members, at least 25% must be independent members. The County Council appoints five elected members to the Standards Committee and therefore two independent members are required.
- 4. The appointment of the current independent members of the Standards Committee expires on 30 November 2005. In order that the new appointments can be put to the County Council for approval on 7 December 2005, the following timetable is proposed:
