Minehead to Combe Martin coastal access report issued

On Tuesday 20 June 2017, Natural England submitted its report and proposals to the Secretary of State for coastal access for the 35 miles (56km) stretch of the coast between Minehead and Combe Martin, Somerset.

In accordance with the requirements set out in the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009 Natural England has published the <u>report</u> which is available on the Gov.uk website.

Representations and objections must be received by Natural England **no later** than midnight on Tuesday 15 August 2017.

All objections and representations will be considered before the Secretary of State makes a final decision about the report.

Kimmeridge Bay to Highcliffe coastal access report issued

On Wednesday 21 June 2017, Natural England submitted its report and proposals to the Secretary of State for coastal access for the 41 miles (66km) stretch of the coast between Kimmeridge Bay and Highcliffe, Dorset.

In accordance with the requirements set out in the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009 Natural England has published the <u>report</u> which is available on the Gov.uk website.

Representations and objections must be received by Natural England **no later** than midnight on Wednesday 16 August 2017.

All objections and representations will be considered before the Secretary of State makes a final decision about the report.

Whitstable to Iwade coastal access report issued

On Wednesday 21 June 2017, Natural England submitted its report and proposals to the Secretary of State for coastal access for the 36 miles (58km) stretch of the coast between Whitstable and Iwade, Kent.
