Main Activities during the past Year

- Liaised with officers and developers of the Clarence Street and Morley Street (Old 3M) development.
- Campaigned to stop Cobden Sure Start from closing.
- Help to arrange and support the Loughborough Mela
- Campaigning for a Loughborough Town Council.
- Won the campaign to retain children's heart procedures(ECMO) at Glenfield Hospital.

- Addressed various very local matters including, parking, drainage, disabled bays, road maintenance, traffic signals, school admissions and disabled facilities grants.

Priorities for the future are:

- Support voluntary organisations and try to ensure that grants and participative budgeting is directed towards social priorities.
- Campaign for better funding for the NHS and great performance from our acute services in UHL, mental health in LPP and GP services under our CCG!
- Improving bus services and demand responsive transport for rural routes.
- Introduce road safety improvements and community speeding interventions.
- Continue to campaign with others to reduce casualties involving cycles and pedestrians. Support safer cycle routes.
- Monitor new arrangements and appeals system for Personal Transport Budgets for pupils with severe educational needs and disabilities.
- Oversee changes and appeals to Personal transport budgets for SEN pupils.
- Sufficient high quality school, pre-school and childcare places in the area I represent.
