<u>REVENUE BUDGET 2006/07 AND CAPITAL PROGRAMME</u> 2006/07 TO 2008/09 – OVERALL POSITION

Introduction

1. The purpose of this report is to enable consideration to be given to the proposed revenue budget for 2006/07 and the capital programme for 2006/07 to 2008/09.

Background

2. The Cabinet at its meeting on 12th January 2006 approved a proposed revenue budget and capital programme. Following that meeting, a copy of the report was circulated to all members of the County Council. A further copy is attached for members of the Commission.

3. The Cabinet's budget proposals were circulated to all members of the County Council. In addition, reports setting out the detailed service budgets have been circulated to the following Scrutiny Committees covering their respective areas of responsibility for comment:-

Reports setting out the views of each Committee will be submitted to the Commission. The Cabinet will meet again on 13 th February to consider the outcome of the Scrutiny process and any other comments received and thereafter decide on the recommendations it wishes to put forward to the County Council.
