

Item 13 – Traffic Regulation Order – Beveridge Lane, Elliston – Speed Limit

Comments from the Local Member Mr. M. Wyatt CC

Paragraph 16 contradict paragraph 17. Parish council objects and agrees with me that the rd should be 30mph even though it was 60mph. We feel the road would benefit from continuing to be 30mph due to pedestrian traffic that use the road and for safety purposes.

The bridge which is situated on Beveridge Lane is a major safety concern due to the lack of proper footpath, and speeding traffic is a danger when trying to walk or cycle over the bridge. I have personally walked this area and I can say without doubt that traffic speed is an issue.

I would like to ask members to keep the whole length of the Lane a 30mph zone for public safety for the driver and a growing number of pedestrians that use this regular stretch of rd.
