

Version 3: In this version the LSCSB still operates but as a county/Rutland forum only and members' involvement and direction is achieved via the executive members attending SOG, SPB Exec and SPB as is the case now. This could be enhanced by the OPCC bi-annual forum. SOG still operates as in Version 1.

Monitors landscape and identifies emerging issues from internal and external sources


Turns strategic direction and emerging issues into initiatives to be taken forward by sub-groups and, through SOG/LSCSB, via CSPs. Ensures alignment and integration across sub-groups. Identifies and feeds in issues from internal and external sources

Provides member oversight and assurance of work of CSPs for Leicestershire & Rutland, ensures alignment of work of CSPs with strategic direction of member bodies, identifies issues to feed into SPB process, drawing on member backgrounds and experience.

Provides executive direction for work of CSPs and identifies issues to feed into LSCSB and SPB. Provides quality assurance and control over work of CSPs and advises PCC re effectiveness of CSP work and value for money of delivery. Drives work arising from SPB and SPB Exec

Sets strategic direction in line with terms of reference – addressing behaviours that negatively impact on local communities, including priorities in Police & Crime Plan.

Converts the strategic direction agreed by SPB and prepares delivery plans to realise intended benefits

Identifies C&D issues in local area and prepares plans to address them.

Aligns those plans with strategic direction identified through SPB, Police and Crime Plan and other key emerging threats or national initiatives

Turns the plans of CSPs into operational activities and information sharing, particularly about the management of people, the protection of people and the development of people in local communities. Identifies issues that can be fed into CSPs for further attention. Undertakes problem solving activities with local communities to address people/place related issues

Refers to all governance processes of all organisations participating in work within the SPB led environment. Governance processes contribute to the desired outcomes, help to set and align the strategic agendas and ensure that work undertaken is fit for purpose and achieves the required objectives, in line with the requirements of the communities.

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
