REPORT OF THE EMPLOYMENT COMMITTEE

PAY POLICY STATEMENT 2019/20

Introduction

1. This report concerns the Council's proposed Pay Policy Statement 2019/20.

Background

- 1. Section 38 of the Localism Act 2011 requires local authorities in England and Wales to produce a Pay Policy Statement for each financial year, which must be approved by full Council.
- 2. This statement must set out the Council's policies in relation to:
 - a) The remuneration of its Chief Officers;
 - b) The remuneration of its lowest-paid employees; and
 - c) The relationship between the remuneration of its chief officers and the remuneration of its employees who are not Chief Officers.
- 4. For the purposes of this statement, remuneration includes basic salary, bonuses and other allowances or entitlements related to employment.
- 5. The Council is required to publish the Pay Policy Statement for 2019/20 on or before 1st April 2019.

Key Points

- 6. The proposed Pay Policy Statement which is attached as Appendix A to this report sets out:
 - a) The Council's approach to job evaluation and grading of posts;
 - b) Additional payments that employees are eligible to receive, such as night enhancement, overtime, etc.;
 - c) The Council's pay multiple (the ratio between the highest paid employee and the median average salary of the Council's workforce (excluding schools but including ESPO), is 8.62;
 - d) That there is no distinction between chief officers and other employees in relation to pension entitlements and severance payments;
 - e) The Council's approach to the re-engagement of former employees
- 7. The National Joint Council for Local Government Employee's pay award has also been agreed for 2019/20 and includes a number of fundamental changes to the pay structure. In order to help secure a collective agreement, recognised trade unions have been kept informed of the key principles which

informed the new pay structure. Formal consultations have also commenced with all recognised Trade Unions and the details of the new pay structure have been communicated to employees.
