1) Electoral Division activities

Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

Working with residents to try to deal with transport related problems, whether it be grass cutting, verge maintenance, condition of pavements and roads, street lighting, pot holes, flower bed upkeep, gritting or speeding.

I have also dealt with school admittance procedures, and parking problems caused by school collections.

It has also been my pleasure to support the Grange Park Residents in their work with the National Lottery and Charnwood Borough Council in their so far successful bid for funding of a new community centre at Grange Park.

Engagement with the Council, other statutory bodies and public utility companies (Water, Gas etc) about services in the area

I have tried to resolve queries as quickly as possible, albeit reliant on the Council's officers to service the requests.

I have also dealt with Severn Trent Water over a significant leak affecting the Outwoods - which is a SSSI area, and for some 3 months or more, had been flooded by what was described by Severn Trent as a minor leak - however, this amounted to a huge amount of water, potentially damaging tree roots, in addition to normal rainfall. After my involvement with Severn Trent, the leak was fixed within a week.

Priorities for the immediate future are:

To keep on top of transport related queries raised by residents, in particular to try to find a workable solution to the parking around schools problems.
