Most of these problems have been, or are in the process, of being dealt with. Of particular value to both villages was the clearance of undergrowth and overhanging shrubs and trees on the Barrow Road footpath. Some street lighting was deemed too invasive and other was not enough lighting. Maintenance of grass verges and hedgerows.

Working with officers has been most useful and they have assisted very promptly and courteously.

#### **Engagement with the Council, other statutory bodies and public utility companies (Water, Gas etc) about services in the area**

Have been in touch with other councils, especially the Parish Council and Charnwood Borough Council. On the whole this has worked very well. Have reported monthly, either in person or by written report to both Barrow and Quorn Parish Councils. Have kept them informed of concerns

raised within the villages.

Have held 5 surgeries in each village with relevant Borough Councillors, Cllr. Ranson in Barrow and Cllr. Shepherd and the late Cllr. David Slater in Quorn. Have also attended or given written reports to Annual Parish Meetings.

Have also worked with MP and her case workers on various matters..

**Priorities for the immediate future are:**

Would like to see what improvements could be made to Slash Lane. With the housing developments that have taken place in both Barrow and Sileby without any road improvements both villages now suffer very badly when Slash Lane is flooded, which happens very frequently.
