## **Electoral Division activities**

### Main Activities during the past Year

Consult on School Re-organisation and take soundings from parents, staff and interested parties.

Work with Hathern Parish Council on a range of issues affecting Hathern, especially re-instating cycle signage on Loughborough Road Hathern. This has involved a number of meetings with officers and the Chair of Parish Council.



Work with local residents organisations; for example, Storer and Ashby Ward Residents Group on a range of issues including car parking and residents' preferential parking schemes.

Distribution of regular newsletters and ebulletins to residents. Have also run a number of street surgeries for local residents.

### **Priorities for the immediate future are:**

- Look for some results from the West Loughborough Parking Study (dependent upon Highways & Transportation project)
- Seek protection for Garendon Park and protect Hathern Village from Loughborough expansion.
- Provision of better facilities for young people in Loughborough North and support existing youth service.
