Electoral Division Activities

I was privileged to be elected as a County Councillor in June 2018 after winning a Bi-Election, following a vacancy left by the late Cllr. David Slater who I had known and worked with for many years. I have been involved in numerous projects during the year many relating to highways and traffic issues, including the mini roundabout in the centre of Syston, traffic flow through the town and air pollution all of which issues I am working hard to improve.
