1) Electoral Division activities

Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

I believe keeping my constituents up to date every month through my regular Focus Newsletter which is more useful than producing one report a year. These newsletters are delivered to every house in my division and are paid for by myself and not public funds.

These contain a mixture of local issues I have taken up on behalf of residents and news about the latest council tax rises and service cuts being imposed by the County Council. Any resident who has any issues they want me to take up on their behalf please contact me directly.

Some of the recent issues I have been involved in include:

- Pressing for a comprehensive scheme to tackle on-street parking in Hinckley town centre.
- Fighting for improvements to local NHS services including the retention of an x-ray facility at Hinckley
- Campaigning for improvements to parking around Hinckley Railway Station, in the East and West Close areas.
- Continuing to press for long-awaiting improvements to key junctions in Hinckley and Burbage to improve traffic flow through the town, particularly at the junction of Rugby Road and Hawley Road.
- Pressing for action to tackle speeding on many routes in my division including Southfield Road, Outlands Drive, Rugby Road and Brookside.
- Campaigning to protect vital local bus services which many of my constituents rely on as their only method of getting around.
