1) Electoral Division activities

Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

Working with residents to try to deal with transport related problems, whether it be grass cutting, verge maintenance, condition of pavements and roads, street lighting, pot holes, flower bed upkeep, gritting or speeding. I continue to deal with problems associated with University and College on-street parking.

Community Leadership Role

Supporting Grange Park Residents in their work with the National Lottery and Charnwood Borough Council and seeing the competition and opening of the new community centre at Grange Park – an amazing community facility, created by a great team of residents.

Engagement with the Council, other statutory bodies and public utility companies (Water, Gas etc) about services in the area

I continue to resolve queries as quickly as possible, working with the Council's officers to service the requests. Pothole reporting and response continues to be impressive. Highways recently helped to work with STW over the siting of a works compound near a residents driveway.

Priorities for the immediate future are:

To try to bring clarity, and find workable solutions to creeping on-street parking associated with the university and College. In addition, to find a way of quickly identifying mature trees in highways areas that would appear to be managed by LCC, but often appear not to be so.
