

Weekly COVID-19 Surveillance Report in Leicestershire

Cumulative data from 27/02/2020 - 04/07/2020



For information

- This report summarises the information from the surveillance system which is used to monitor the cases of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic in Leicestershire.
- The report is based on daily data up to 4 July 2020.
- The maps presented in the report examine counts and rates of COVID-19 at Middle Super Output Area. Middle Layer Super Output Areas are a census based geography used in the reporting of small area statistics in England and Wales. The minimum population is 5,000 and the average is 7,200.
- Disclosure control rules have been applied to all figures not currently in the public domain. All counts have been rounded to the nearest 5 and those between 1 to 7 have been suppressed.
- Data has been sourced from Public Health England. The report has been compiled by Strategic Business Intelligence in Leicestershire County Council.

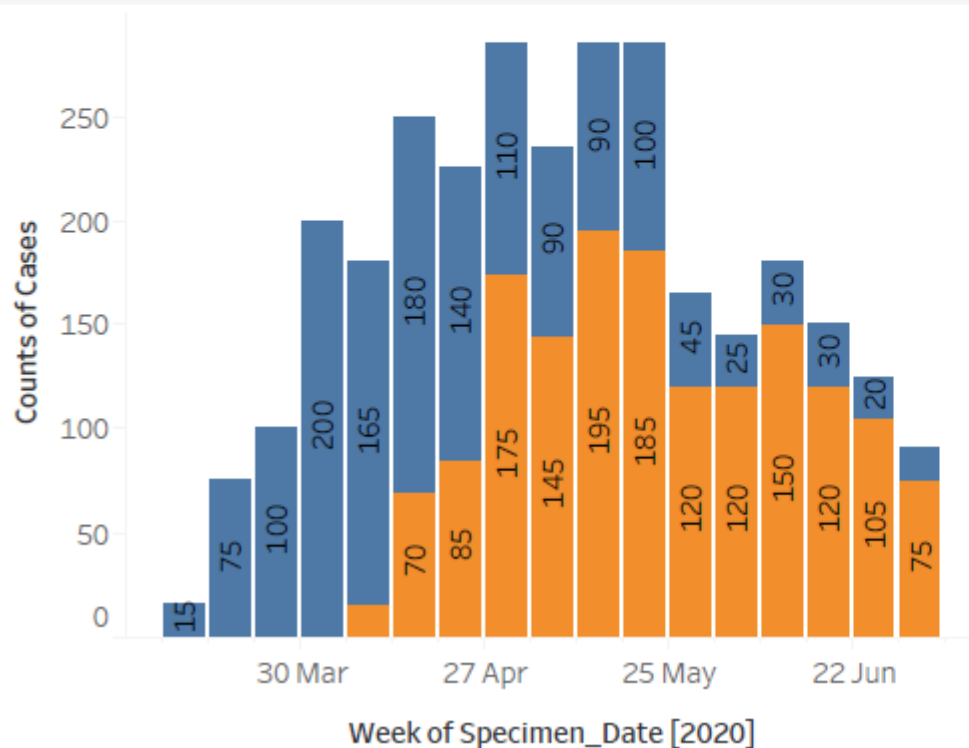

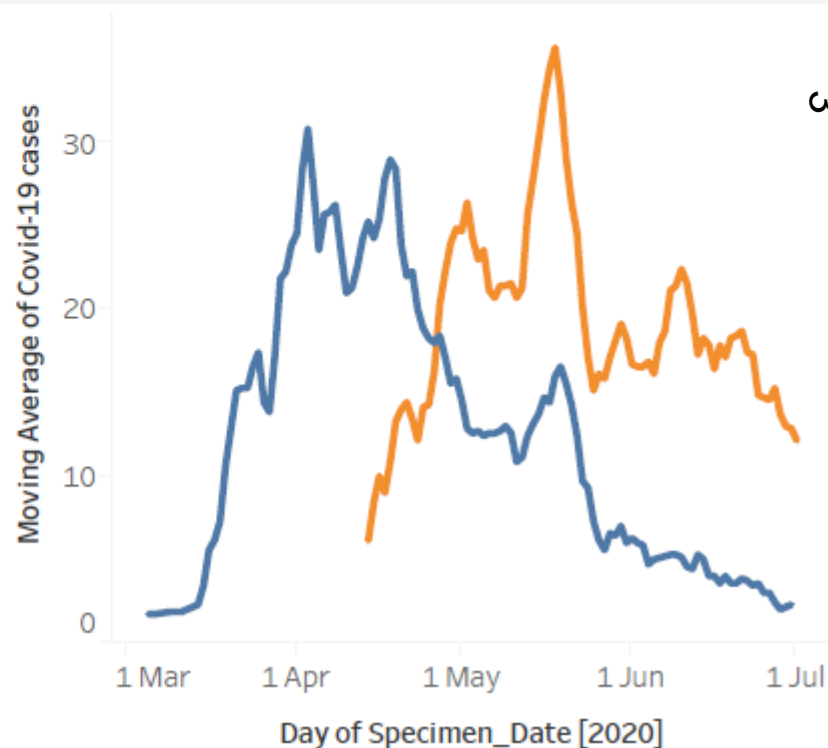

Cases per week



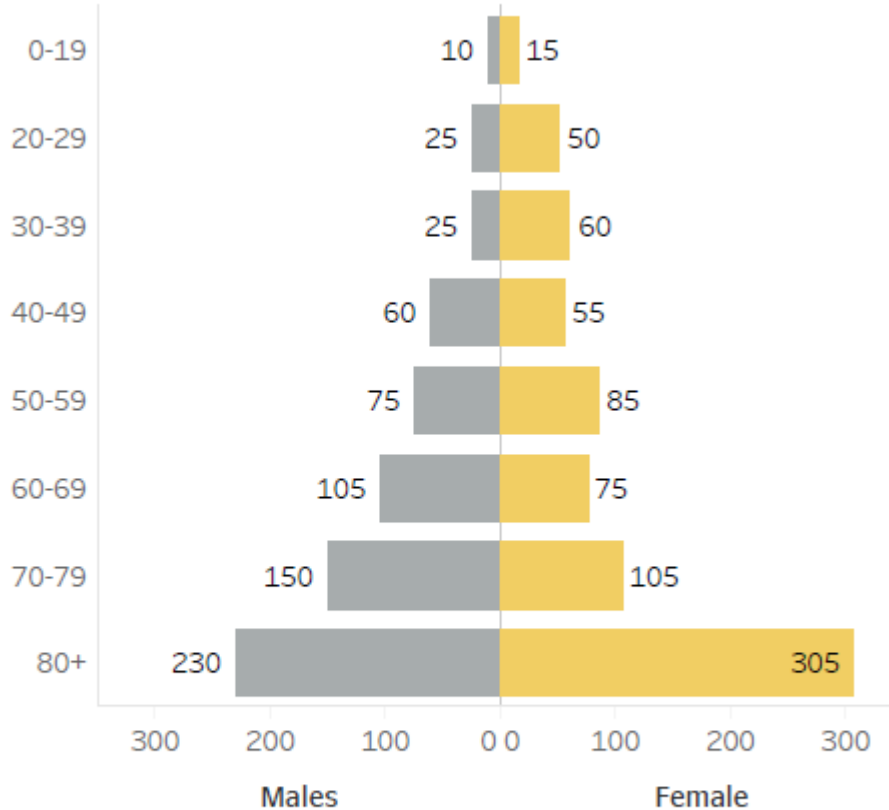
Moving average of cases per day



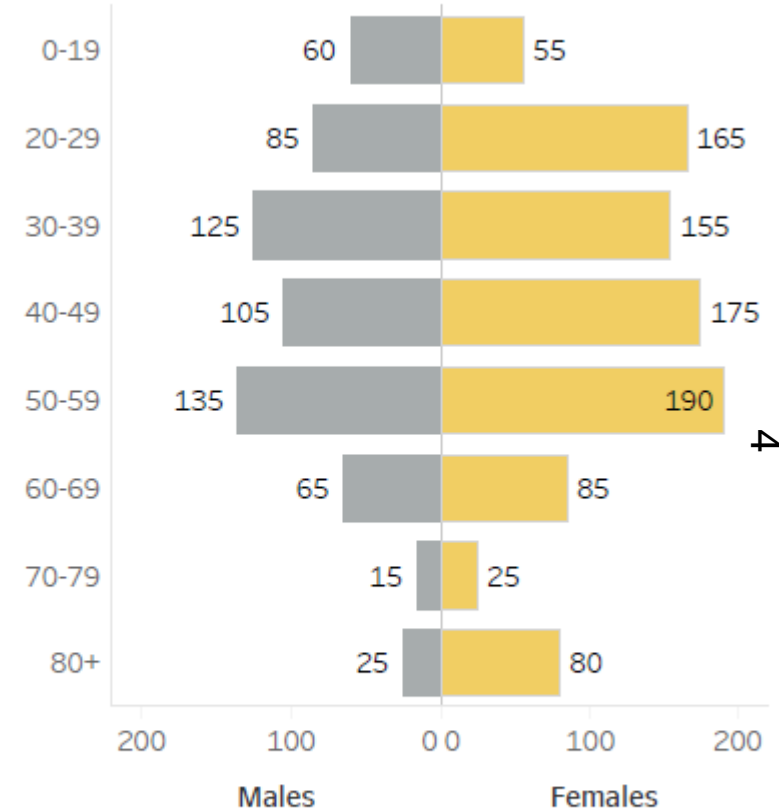

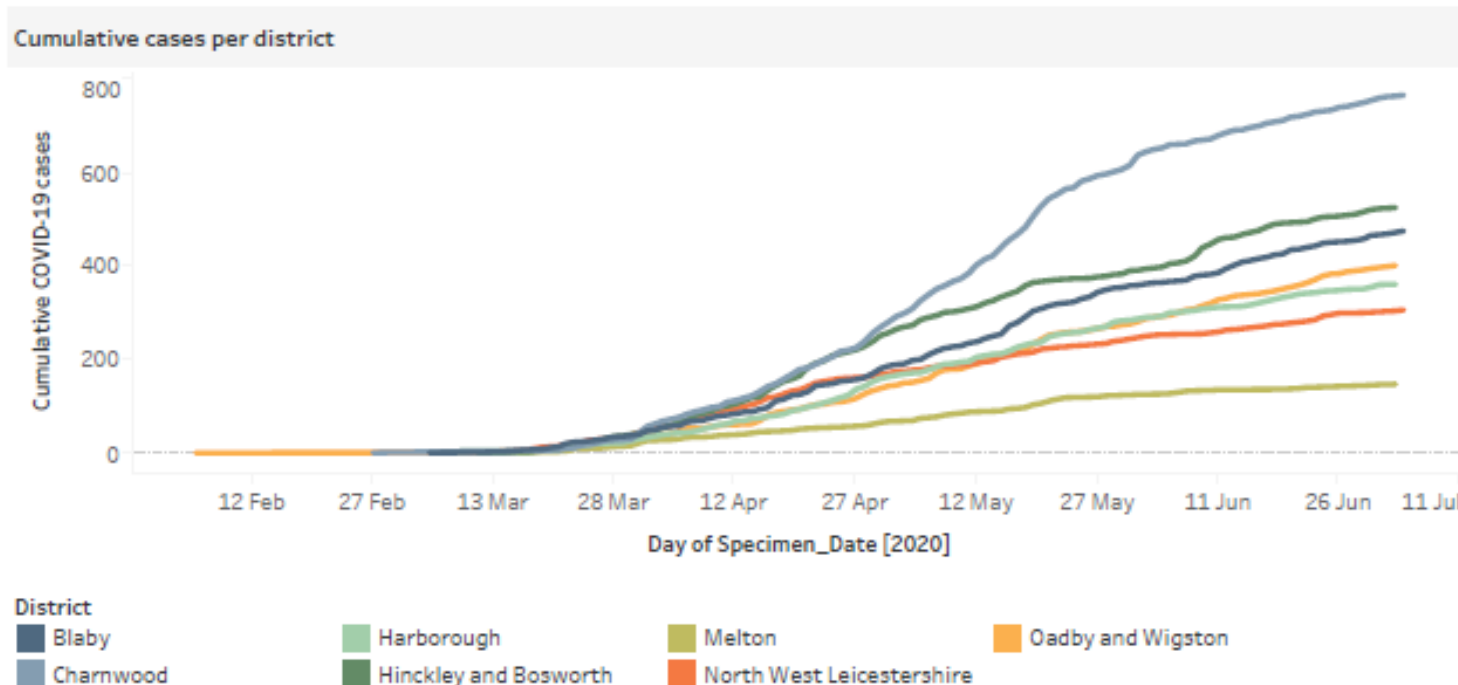

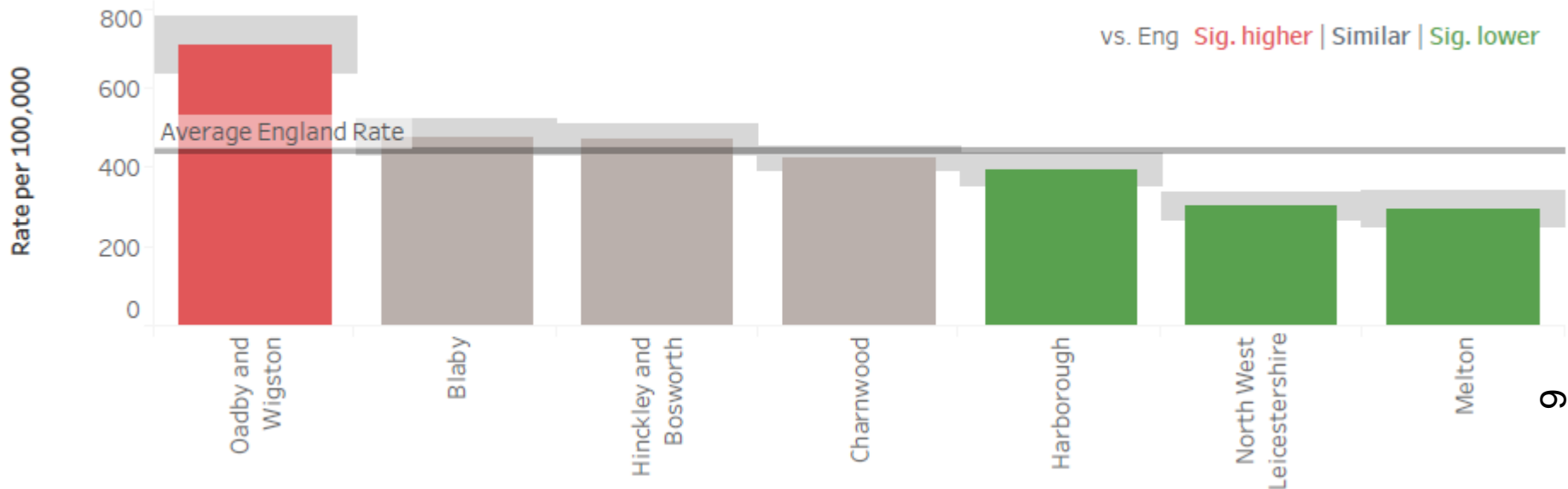

Rate of Cumulative Cases by District

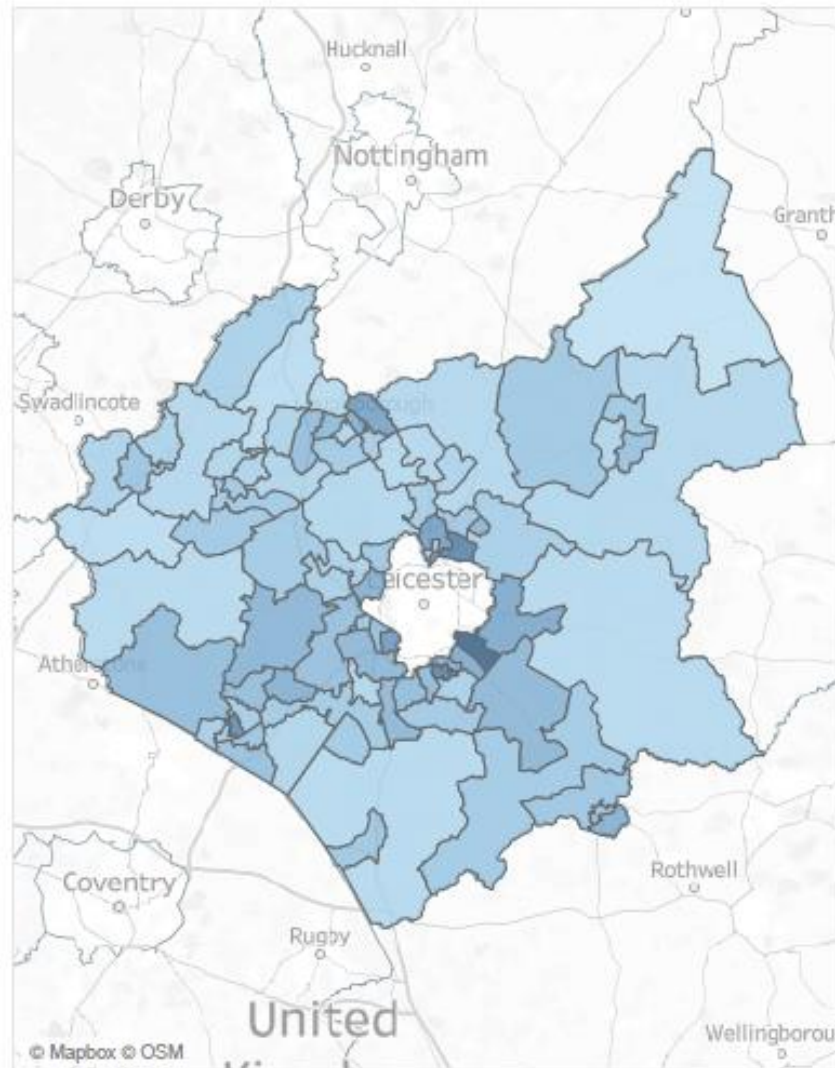
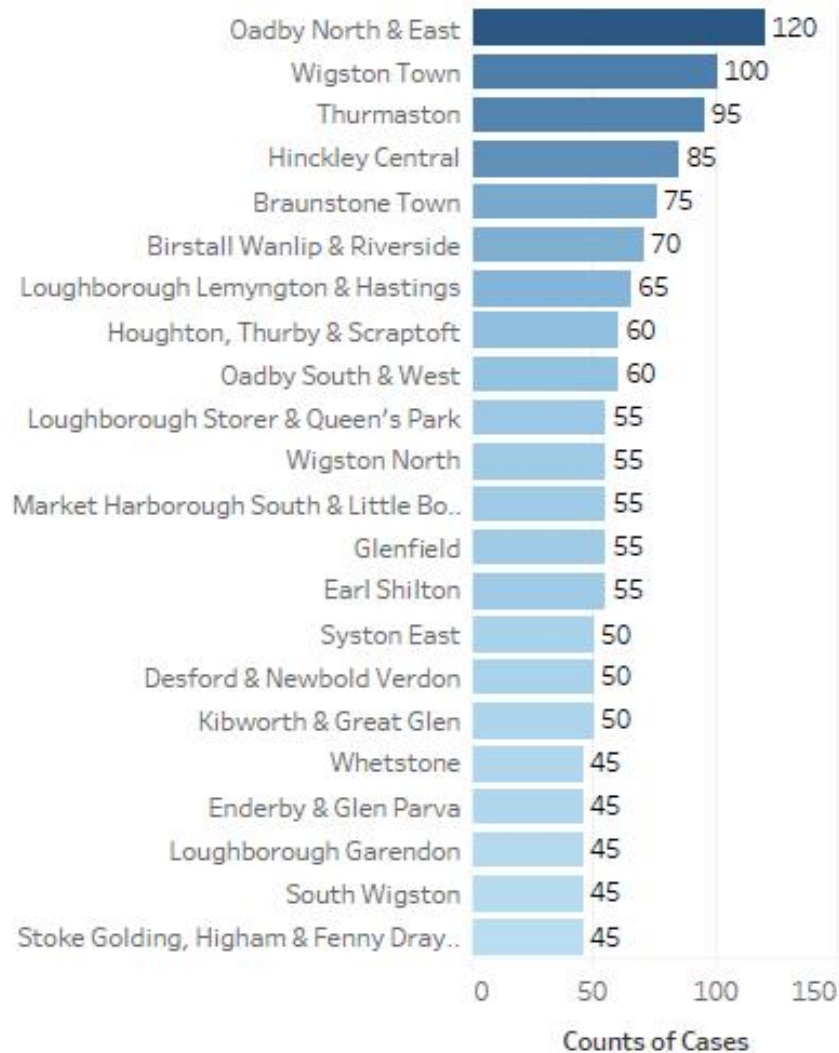
Rate of cumulative cases per 100,000 population by district



- Oadby & Wigston is the only district in the county which has a significantly higher rate of COVID-19 cases compared to the national average.
- Blaby, Hinckley & Bosworth and Charnwood have a similar rate compared to the national average.
- Harborough, North West Leicestershire and Melton have a significantly lower rate than the national average.

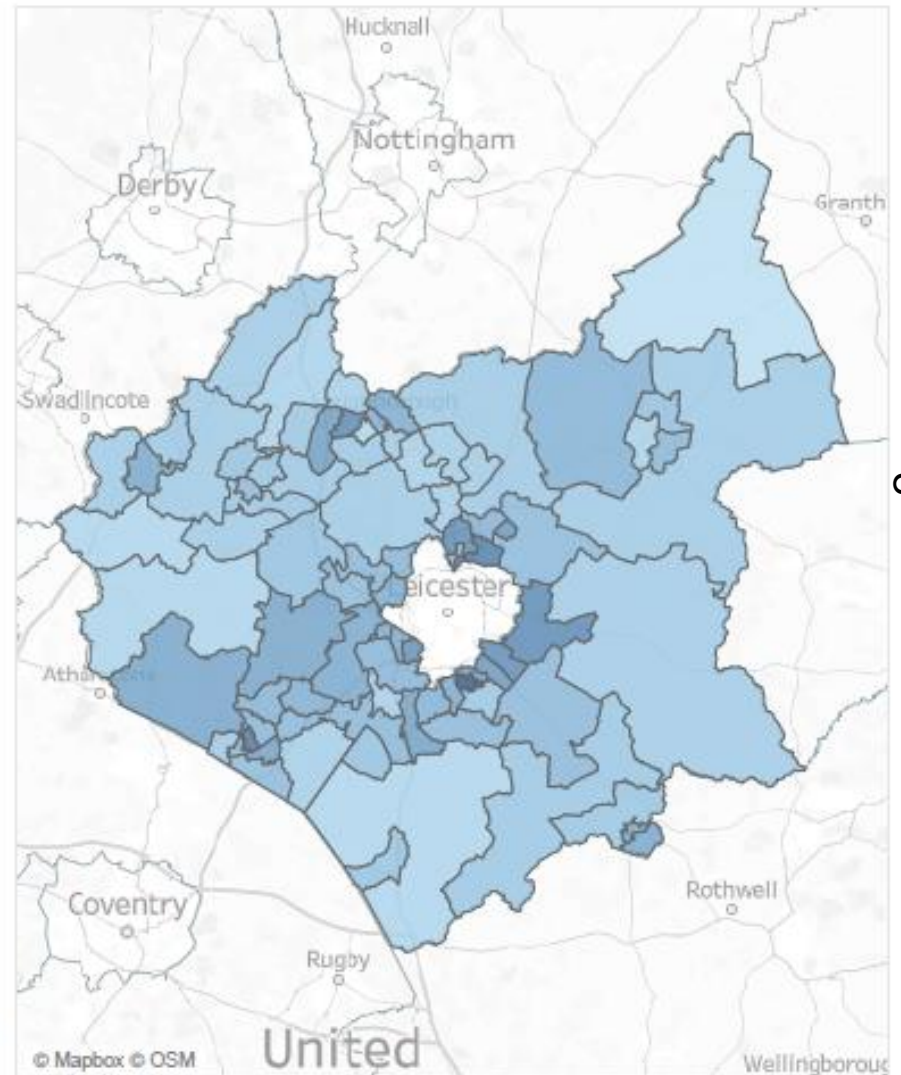
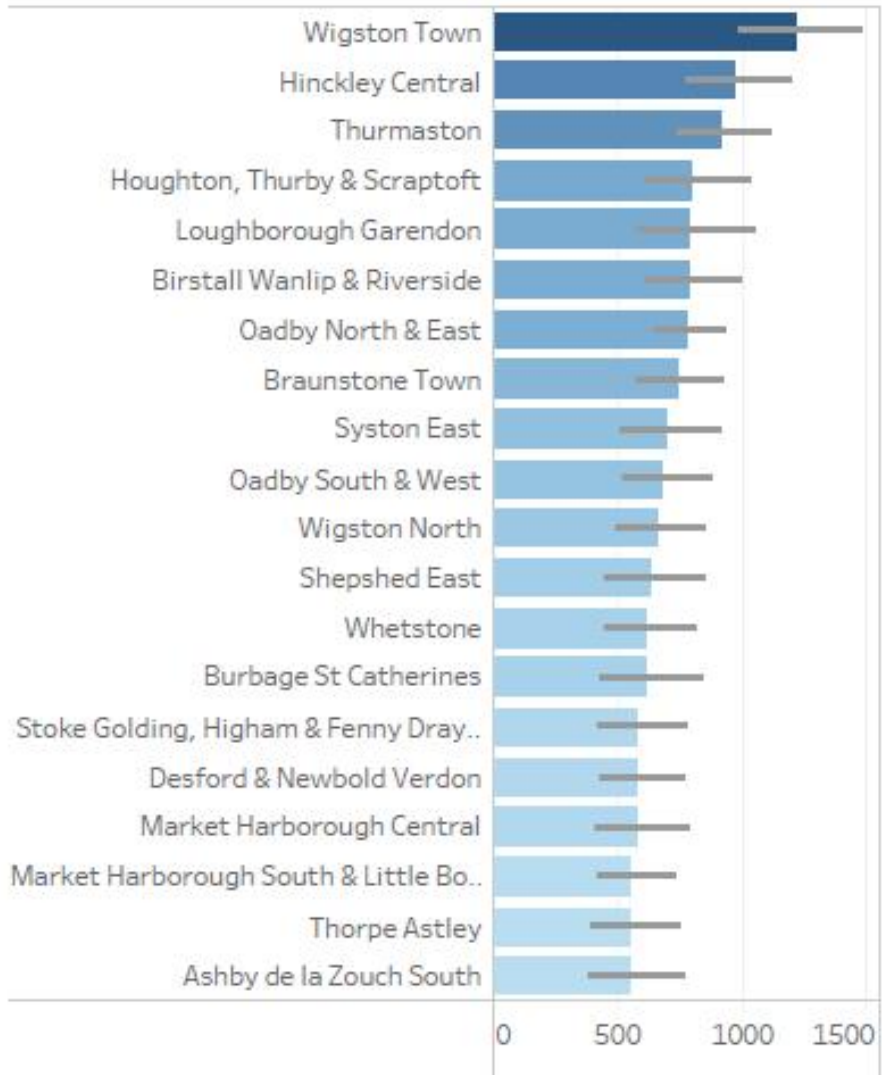
Counts of Cumulative Cases by MSOA

Confirmed COVID-19 cases by MSOA



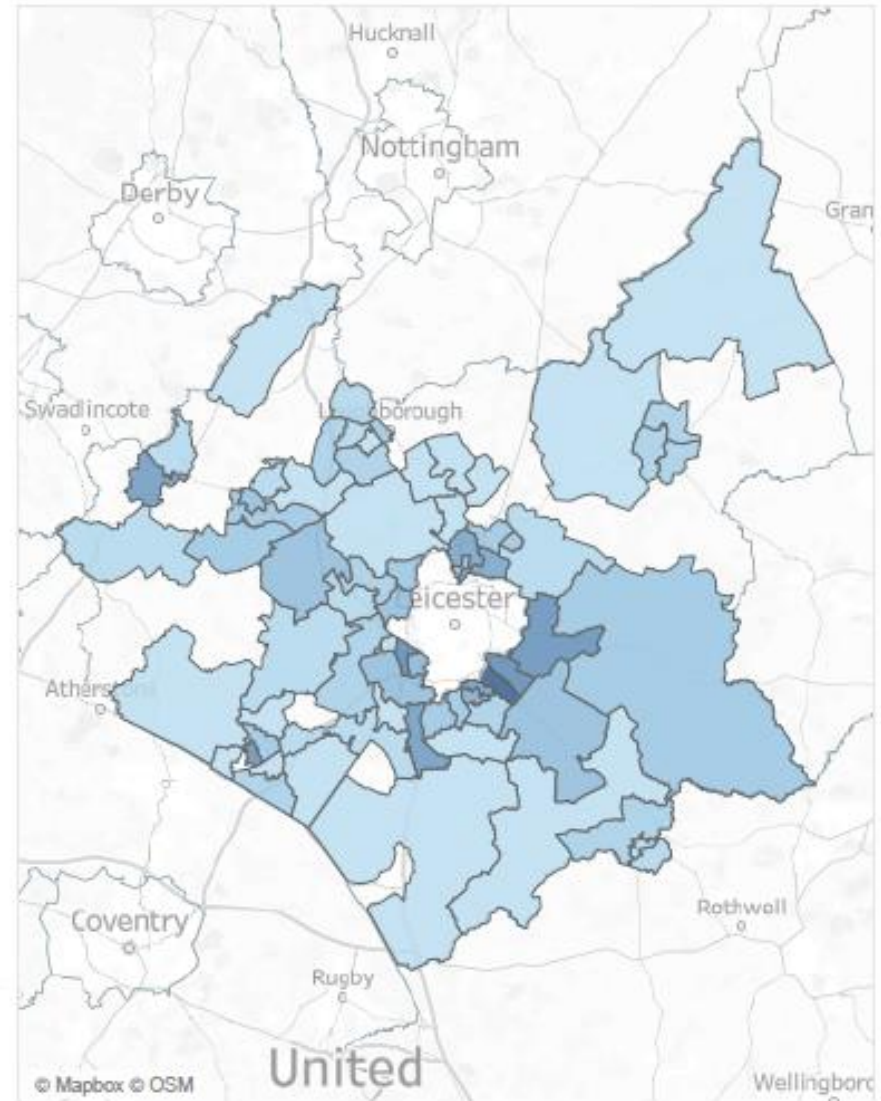
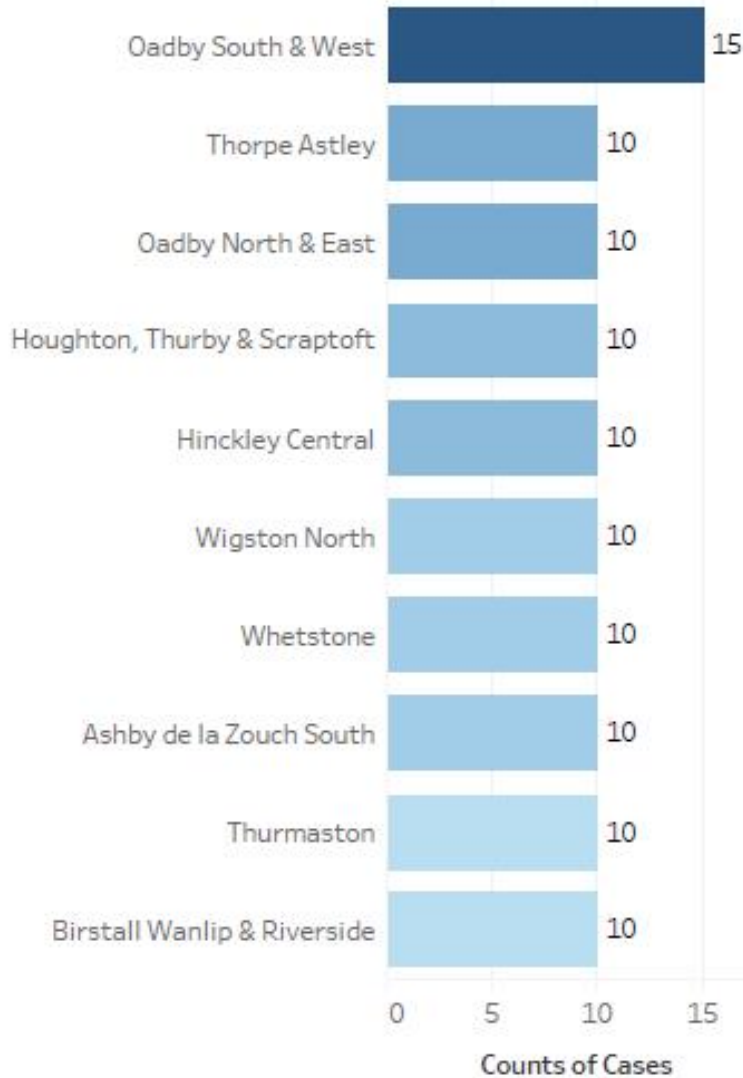
Rate of Cumulative Cases by MSOA

Confirmed COVID-19 rates per 100,000 population by MSOA



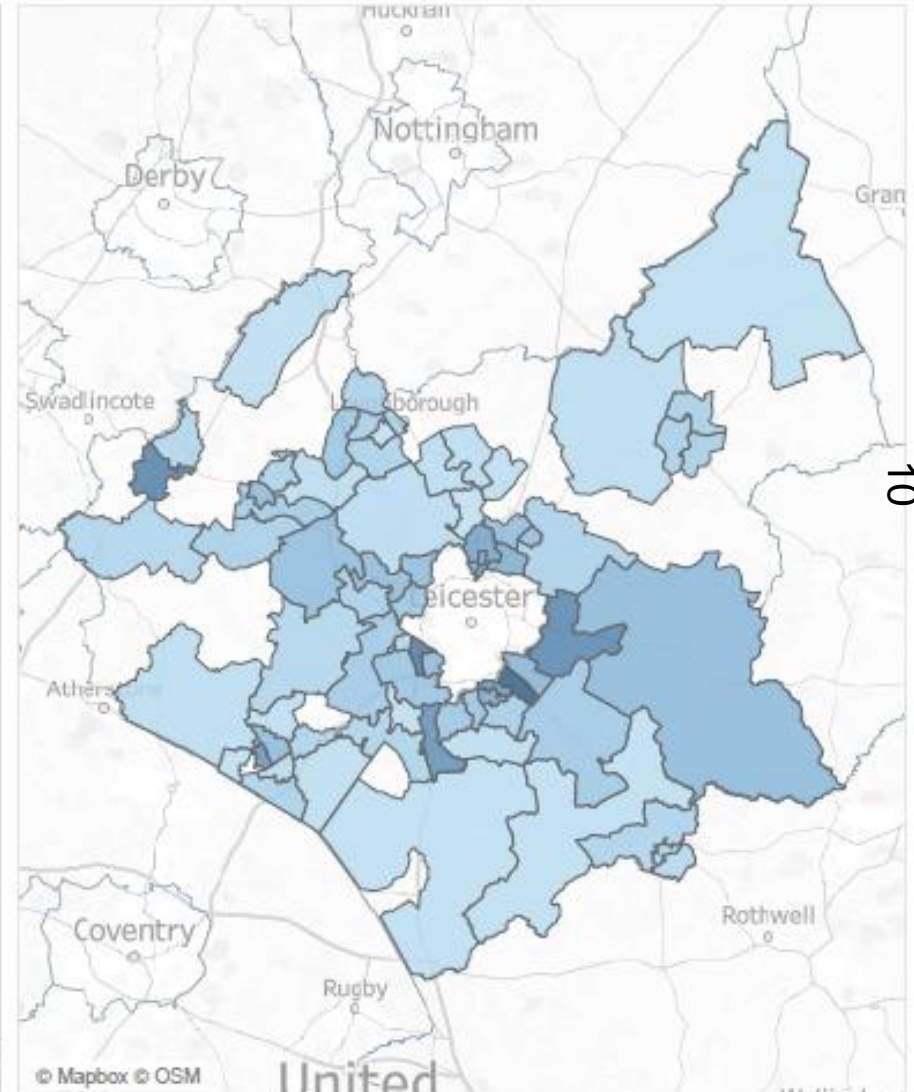
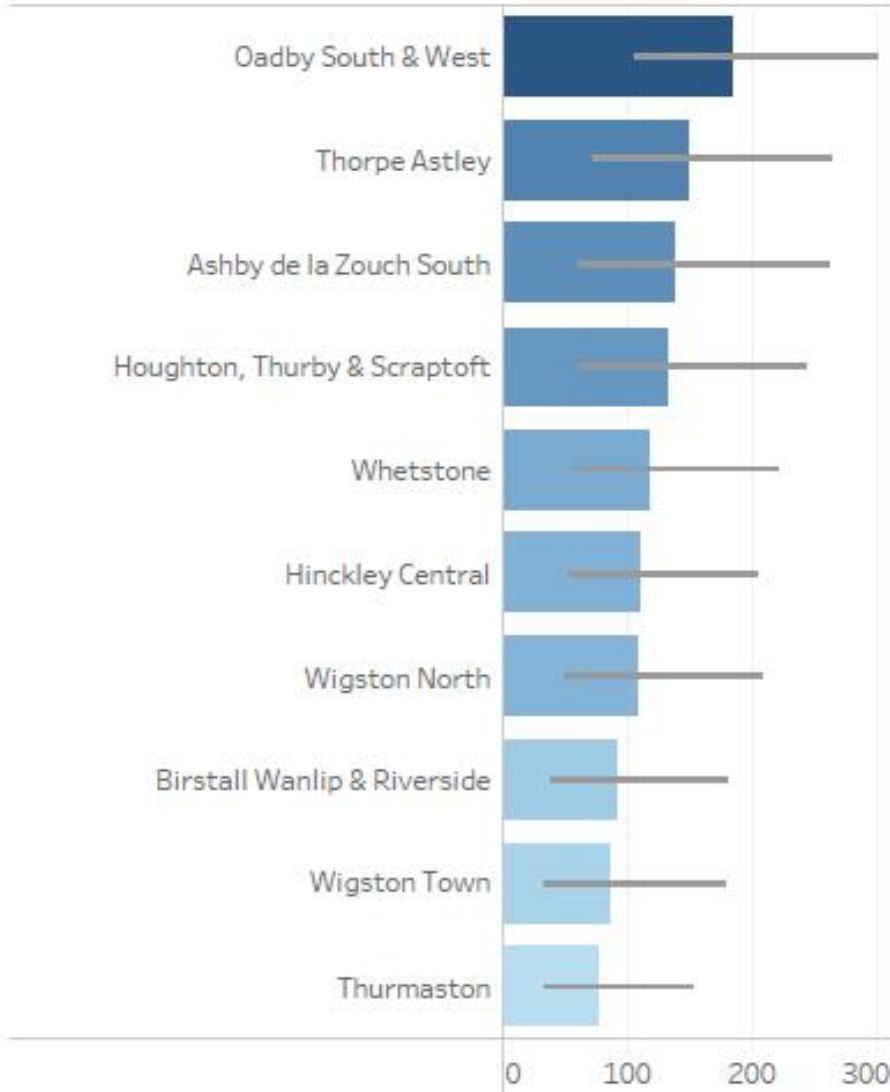
Fortnightly Counts of Cases by MSOA
