De Montfort Division

In my role as County Councillor for Hinckley De Montfort I have taken up a number of issues for residents

Speeding problems

A serious issue for many residents in Hinckley De Montfort is problems with speeding traffic. In particular I've raised the problems of speeding on Leicester Road, Ashby Road/Normandy Way and Middlefield Lane.

Big Pit development

I continue to oppose the housing development on the Big Pit site off Ashby Road and has raised with County Highways the problem of unacceptable levels of dirt and mud on pavements and roads near the site.

Pot holes

I've reported potholes on numerous roads locally such as Drake Way, Netherley Road and Stoneygate Drive for repair.

Health service

I continue to campaign for the government to deliver the improvements to local health services in Hinckley that have been promised. The Hinckley urban area has the second largest population in the county after Loughborough and Michael believes local residents deserve quality health care.

Fair funding

Leicestershire has the lowest level of financial support from the government meaning our area doesn't receive the level of services that other areas benefit from. I continue to campaign for fair funding for Leicestershire.
