

Which of these options for school term time and holiday patterns (for community, voluntary controlled, and community special schools in Leicestershire) would you prefer?






Q2b: Please tell us about the location of the following...School(s) your children/ grandchildren attend (tick all that apply)






Are you providing your organisation's official response to the consultation?
