I was elected in May 2021 during the height of the Covid-19 Pandemic. This provided some challenges due to 'Lockdowns' and the general heightened reluctance for activities being out and about and mingling with constituents these were still held online and in 'virtual' forums.

I continue to be an active member of all the Committee Meetings:

- 3. Public Seating Bench; Florence Wragg Way, Oadby
- 4. Bollards outside Brookside Primary School, Oadby
- 5. Tarmac resurfacing to create a proper pedestrian walkway from Woodfield Road to Upland Park, a shortcut used to access the school, and elderly people making it particularly easy for the disabled to use via mobility scooters.

My progress has been limited as unfortunately, I have been affected by some serious health issues since my election; I suffered from Covid-19 (like many others) however this led to a mini-stroke and I am still under ongoing investigations.
