## **Electoral Division activities**

Thank you to everyone who placed their trust and belief in me to return me as your Elected County Councillor for the Cosby & Countesthorpe Division.

It is always a humbling experience, an honour and a privilege to serve and represent those who elect me and everyone in our communities. We are blessed to live in a democracy and whether you voted for me or for another candidate, it is my honour to represent each and every resident with equal favour throughout my division.

Despite the Covid-19 pandemic, lock-down and the immense impacts on everybody's lives, in most respects my work within our communities has continued but, as with most people, without the benefit of face-to-face meetings.

Covid-19 did and continues to highlight the very best in community spirit in people, their passions; their support for their communities and their support for one another - I thank everyone for this and most especially through the Covid-19 pandemic.

Covid-19 continues to curtail most of our activity in public life but emails, Social Media; telephones, virtual meetings and letters have ensured that we have been able to continue our work and support our residents.

I live in the division with my specialist Early Years SEND Nursery Nurse wife of many years Jackie who; as a Key Worker has worked throughout the pandemic looking after some of our most vulnerable children and I can only stand back and admire the risk-taking, commitment and dedication of Key Workers.

### **Current divisional matters**: -

There are a number of resident and community issues that I have been working on, some of which are noted below: -

 South Whetstone – Delighted to have been able to support a successful outcome with a number of families and their campaign for re-admissions to Badgerbrook Primary School

- Countesthorpe I continue to work with a local business person to try and secure
  a new Post Office for the village. This is proving to be far more bureaucratic and
  difficult than ever expected and we have secured the support of and work with our
  local MP, Alberto Costa.
- Wistow as County Highway work schedules come back on-stream, I will
  continue to press for action at the Wistow crossroads as a well known accident
  black spot.
- Cosby Formal application for an extended School Safety Zone outside Cosby Primary School
- Kilby working alongside residents, Members and Officers of Kilby Parish Council, work continues on traffic issues and road surface failures in the village. Covid-19 has introduced considerable delays and backlogs of work for the County Highway Authority, but we continue to press for solutions and resolutions and I am also delighted to have won the support of the Regional Managing Director of a major housing developer who has contacted all their contractors who are travelling through Kilby to remind them to comply with speed limits and show respect for the Kilby residents.
- **Cosby** Supporting Cosby Parish Councill with numerous traffic and weight restriction issues within the village
- Cosby I am delighted to have been able to help resolve a family's ongoing issues relating to Adult Social Care costs.
- Countesthorpe Supporting a local business person with a new dedicated business network group. The Countesthorpe Enterprise Network was due to launch on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 but following the extension of Covid-19 restrictions, we are now planning to launch in September 2021.
- Cosby Perhaps my most single rewarding success was and should be being able to champion a family's desperate need for help and ensure that the right care and support was put in place for a family with a young child with Special Educational Needs. Nothing could give me greater personal reward than to hear how a family's life and the child's life has been transformed since my intervention but that is absolutely why we are here, to help you when you need us.

#### County Council activities - (Bodies served on at County Hall)

Initially joining Leicestershire County Council in the latter quarter of the 2017-2021 electoral term meant that the opportunity to be appointed to Council Committees was limited. On the positive, that meant that I was able to act as a substitute on a number of committees allowing me to find my feet, get to know my fellow Councillors and Council Officers and get up to speed with the business of the day across the County Council.

Having been returned as your Elected County Councillor for the 2021 – 2025 electoral term, I look forward to being able to play a full role within the County Council and to serving the people and businesses within the division to the very best of my ability.
