Virtual and in-person surgeries held across Markfield and Desford; with further surgeries scheduled for Bagworth, Thornton and Stanton in the Summer of 2022.



In my role as Cabinet Lead for Recovery & Transformation I have been involved in promoting 'Work & Skills Leicestershire' which to date had helped hundreds of Leicestershire residents reskill or get back into the employment market.



Allocated £25k of investment, from the Members Highways Fund, for initiatives such as Mobile Vehicle Activated Signs to tackle speeding.
