Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

Speeding traffic remains a serious issue in the Whitwick Division. Highways maintenance, Severe weather conditions (snow) affecting village roads, Planning matters, Environment issues, Street lighting and fighting crime, Grass cutting and weed spraying, Constituents enquiries. I have been working with the County and the Police to improve all the above.

Having street lighting switched on all night to help residents feel safer, Helping local businesses obtain grant funding from LCC. Improving the winter gritting programme.
