Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

Supporting isolated and vulnerable residents in Melton Wolds. Following the lockdown in March 20 it was clear many were struggling through the impact of the pandemic. As the LCC member for the patch I was able to help, advise many particularly those suffering with rural isolation. I would often drop into people at their home and catch up with their needs by speaking through their windows plus regular telephone calls. Emails became even more important though this time. I also received contact through Facebook Messenger. Certainly in a rural area Facebook & Twitter became invaluable.

Community Leadership Role

Representing a large rural ward presents challenges of attending Parish Council meetings. However through the pandemic all 14 parish Councils took to using Zoom meetings. This was helpful as my attendance at the meetings dramatically increased due to a saving of not driving around the division. Emails & telephone calls became more important too.

I noted a rise through the year of residents needing help plus advice through a difficult time.
