1) Electoral Division activities

Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

Continue to oppose inappropriate development in Burbage and surrounding areas. Raise parking/road markings as appropriate/ TRO for Lutterworth Road. Grass cutting/hedging/road signage and street lights also addressed.
