Some Highlights over the last 12 months:

- Meeting the Chancellor Jeremy Hunt at No 11 Downing Street to discuss options for a better funding settlement for Leicestershire.
- Planting 250,000 trees in the County towards our target of 700,000- that's one for every resident working towards a cleaner and greener Leicestershire.
- Opposing the Segro and the Freeport expansion locally.
- Welcoming over 1000 Ukrainian people including 350 children fleeing war.
- Making £22M available to help people with increased costs of living.
- Investing an extra £57M safeguarding and protecting vulnerable people.
- An extra £3M investment in highway maintenance.
