Electoral Division activities

Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

To improve the health and life expectancy of residents.

The life expectancy is ten years lower in this division than in neighbouring divisions. Breathing problems and asthma are higher, particularly amongst children.

Community Leadership Role

There is a new project involving Public Health, County Highways, Schools and Oadby and Wigston Borough Council. The project will seek to address the high prevalence of asthma and viral wheeze cases in the under 15's The equipment for air quality arrived June 2023.

Engagement with the Council, other statutory bodies and public utility companies (Water, Gas etc) about services in the area

Various water and gas leaks have been reported. Some on several occasions, particularly when a water leak was causing ice on a busy road.

Working with Rail Track and local schools on an art display on a local railway bridge to prevent graffiti and to improve the environment of the station by the addition of CCTV.

Priorities for the immediate future are:

Continuing with the campaign to improve the air quality for the residents.
