The main problems brought to my attention with public utility companies has been with Severn Trent Water. With numerous road closures and or partial road closures. It is felt by residents that not enough information is given prior to repairs, particularly to residents whose properties are mainly affected. I hope to be in contact with them to see if this can be improved.

Priorities for the immediate future are:

There are still ongoing after effects of the lockdowns. This is particularly noticed with regard to children and families. As chair of the Children and Families Overview and Scrutiny Committee this falls heavily on the Department. All the officers in this department particularly have worked exceptionally hard to mitigate the problems and this has been recognised nationally. Extra strain has been put on the service, and other services across the council, with the ongoing conflict in Ukraine and also illegal immigration. The council has risen to the challenge. This will continue, I feel, for sometime to come.
