# **Electoral Division activities**

#### Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

I have engaged with the Parish Councils in my Division to discuss the spending of the Highway Members Fund. As a result, I have been able to help deliver the significant funding for new Community Bus in Broughton Astley,a vehicle activated speed signs for Dunton Bassett and road safety signs for Ashby Magna. Contributions from the Member Highway Fund have also been spent on improvements in Ashby Parva and Leire.

I have helped to obtain an offer of a new bus shelter for Croft Road, Broughton Astley.

I have supported the new Puffin control crossing in Cosby Road, Broughton Astley as well as a number of Highway resurfacing requirements throughghout my Division.

I have held a several councillor surgeries this past year and followed up on a number of resident concerns to satisfactorily resolve issues brough to my attention.

## **Community Leadership Role**

I attend on a regular basis the Parish Councils in my Division. These are at Broughton Astley, Dunton Bassett Ashby Magna, Ashby Parva, Leire and Frolesworth. I engage with the Parish Councillors and the residents of these villages to learn of issues of concern and to take these up where applicable with the County. In addition, I have surgeries (three in the past year) to meet residents other than at the Parish Council meetings.

I advertise my contact details throughout the Division and have a regular magazine article in the Broughton Astley In Touch magazine to inform residents of my activities.

I meet regularly with the local Member of Parliament (Alberto Costa) to discuss issues affecting both the the Division and the County – notably on fair funding for Leicestershire and Devolution.

# Engagement with the Council, other statutory bodies and public utility companies (Water, Gas etc) about services in the area

I have made a number of enquiries on Highway issues in particular at County and have been in discussions with Severn Trent on drainage and water issues in the Division.

#### Priorities for the immediate future are:

I look forward to satisfactorily resolving highway and speeding issues in the Division. I continue to engage with the communities in my Division to resolve issues that arise. I am meeting the representatives of the local County Highways Team to discuss a programme of improvements within my Division.
