#### Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

I was elected Vice Chairman of Leicestershire County Council for the year 22/23. My work was mainly evenings and weekends representing the Chairman.

I was however, able to attend all my Scrutiny Committees at County Hall.

I attended all my Parish Councils on a regular basis through out the year whenever I could.

# Engagement with the Council, other statutory bodies and public utility companies (Water, Gas etc) about services in the area

North West Leicestershire is one of the fastest growing District Councils in the country. This means I have a close interaction with many pf the statutory bodies and utility companies. The District Council Planning Department is probably one of my most frequent port of calls followed by the Police then Water. Those organisations make up the bulk of my case work.

#### Priorities for the immediate future are:

I have already mentioned previously that North West Leicestershire is one of the fastest growing District Councils in the Country. This has however, had a major impact on highways. New home developments average between 500 to 1000 new homes which means greater vehicle movement. One site close to my own County Division that is in the process of being completed will have 4000 new homes and we therefore need strategic strategy for highways relating to developments.

My second priority has to be the current financial position of the County Council. This is well known in that we are sadly one of the worst funded County Councils in the country. We need to address this.
