Electoral Division activities

Main Activities and the impact during the past year:

The Belvoir Division is a large area with 32 villages and 12 Parish Councils, this brings in a fair amount of case work which is very wide and varied. Over the last year I have been finalising the Members Highways Fund projects and also working with the Parish Councils and a number of issues that include impacts of the work with the MMDR, verge mowing, speeding traffic, requests for road speeds to be re classified downwards, flooding particularly when a culvert goes under a village, children's homes, overhanging trees and concerns over increased music festivals.

Community Leadership Role

The information that I provide to Parish Councils regarding the work of the County Council is always very well received and can be of benefit to residents in the division and includes details of the LCC tree strategy, LCC supported home improvements, flooding support and EV charging points.

Engagement with the Council, other statutory bodies and public utility companies (Water, Gas etc) about services in the area

There is often engagement with the main utility companies as the work that they carry out has an impact on local communities and road closures.

Priorities for the immediate future are:

The division still has major concerns over speeding traffic, increased congestion in villages and of most concern is flooding issues, which are ongoing.
