The Rutland Domestic Abuse Partnership Board meeting has health, police, Rutland County Council, LWA and Freeva representatives that attend the board. The MOD also attends these meetings due to two army bases being located in Rutland.

The Rutland Domestic Partnership Board oversees the working group and identifies any themes from the agencies in relation to domestic abuse in Rutland. The Partnership Board updates the Safer Rutland Partnership Board with work being completed.

The Working Group to date has focused on supporting raising awareness campaigns within the workforce for children and adult social care.
