 - (b) That the Scrutiny Commission be asked to consider the outcomes of the Scrutiny Review Panel on Energy, together with the principles of the Notice of Motion in the name of Mr Bown, which the Council welcomes, with a view to considering the Council's existing response to the Environment agenda and recommending to the Cabinet and the Council an appropriate way forward and further action plans in respect of the

Environment Strategy and other related strategies such as Climate Change and Waste.

7. A report setting out the Council's existing response to the environment agenda will be submitted to the next meeting of the Commission. That report will take into consideration comments made by the Commission in relation to the findings of this Review Panel.
