MEDIUM TERM FINANCIAL STRATEGY 2008/09 TO 2010/11

Introduction

1. The purpose of this report is to enable consideration to be given to the proposed Medium Term Financial Strategy 2008/09 to 2010/11.

Background

2. The Cabinet at its meeting on 10th January 2008 approved the Medium Term Financial Strategy which incorporated the 2008/09 revenue budget and 2008/11 Capital Programme as a basis for consultation with stakeholders, including scrutiny committees. A copy of the report considered by the Cabinet was circulated to all members of the County Council as an Information Item on 4th January. A further copy is attached for members of the Commission. Also attached is a supplementary paper (Appendix 1) which summarises the main changes since the budget was initially prepared.
