

Role of Scrutiny Commissioners

- Effective discharge of the overview and scrutiny function including scrutiny of external bodies and report to Council thereon on an annual basis.
- Identify and keep under review topics to be addressed by Scrutiny Committees and Panels, taking into account member and officer capacity.
- Maintain a 'critical friend' relationship with the Executive.
- Advise on all issues of training of scrutiny members and the future development of scrutiny.

Role of Deputy Commissioners

- To share the chairing of Panels which are established by the Scrutiny Commission.
- In light of experience, to advise Commissioners on possible review topics and changes to working methods and processes.
- Produce an Annual Report on their activities for the Scrutiny Commissioners.



<u>Budget and Performance Monitoring</u> – A Standing Panel (chaired by a Commissioner) to meet to consider quarterly performance reports.
