Standing Order 1(2) requires that in addition to the Annual Meeting of the Council and any meetings convened by the Chairman or members of the Council, meetings of the Council for the transaction of general business shall be held on such days as may be determined by the Council at its annual meeting on the recommendation of the Cabinet. A date so determined may be varied by the Cabinet. Standing Order 1(4) also makes it necessary for the Council to fix a date in February for the Council's budget meeting.
