Is the "One Chance Rule" understood by most relevant local authority officers and teachers?

This is considered well embedded in the culture, but as always remain subject to human factors in reporting. The policy is clearly laid down.

This is heavily stressed in training to all Leicestershire police officers and reinforced at every opportunity. It is difficult to see how it could be take any further forward with the police. The same probably does not apply in all case to the other agencies that may become involved with the issue.
