1	One or more family members with ASB or other crime issues	Criminal Justice
2	Violence or abuse affects the family or is a significant risk	Criminal Justice
3	Family does not make full use of education and training	Education
4	A child has significant difficulties at or with school and formal education (may be SEN or truancy)	Education
5	Poor parental educational attainment	Education
6	Family heavily or solely reliant on state benefits	Employment
7	There are young people in the household who are not in employment, education or training	Employment
8	Family has no or limited support network from family or friends	Family
9	Single parent family	Family
10	Unstable home life	Family
11	The security/safety of a child is at significant risk	Family
12	Difficulties looking after children/poor parenting skills	Family
13	Inability of parent(s) to manage finances leading to debt issues	Family
14	A teenager in the household is a mother or expectant mother	Family
15	Significant risk to a child's life(self harming)	Family
16	Child Protection Plan - Closed	Family
17	Child Protection Plan - Open	Family
18	At least one child of the family is or has been in care	Family
19	Family has at least one member with mental health issues or significant risk thereof	Health
20	Child is a carer	Health
21	Ability of one or more family members to communicate is significantly impaired	Health
22	Risk of neglect to a child or children	Health
23	One or more family members have a significant limiting disability or illness	Health
24	Alcohol misuse is a major issue for the family	Health
