Purpose of Report

1. To present the proposed draft Police and Crime Plan 2013-17.

Recommendation

2. The Police and Crime Panel (PCP) is asked to comment and provide feedback on the draft Police and Crime Plan 2013-17.

Background

3. Under the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, a Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) is required to publish a Police and Crime Plan before the end of the financial year in which they take office. This Plan should outline the strategic policing objectives for their full period of office (to run to the end of the financial year in which their term of office expires). The Chief Constable is required to manage the operational resources under his control with the aim of achieving these objectives. Whilst the PCC is entitled to set whatever objectives he sees to be appropriate, the Chief Constable has the operational independence to seek to fulfil these objectives.

Consultation

5. The PCC will undertake a pro-active consultation and engagement process during February and early March. This will include obtaining the views of a wide range of people including partners and stakeholders. The deadline for comments to be submitted to the Chief Executive is 10 March 2013.

Publication

6. The final plan will be published by 31 March 2013. On publication, the initial Plan will cover the period up to 31 March 2017.
