We, the under signed request that you acknowledge the concerns we have regarding the withdrawal of our warden service currently operating in our sheltered homes for the elderly and vulnerable

We wish you to seriously consider the points and concerns below, and consequences that such action, if taken will have

This will not only affect the wellbeing of the residents, which of course is paramount- but inevitably will affect our stretched social service departments and the NHS, not to mention the additional costs this will involve on local budgets

YOU HAVE A DUTY OF CARE TO THE ELDERLY AND VULNERABLE

PLEASE THINK AGAIN!!!!

1. Daily personal visit to each resident to check on their health and wellbeing pre-empts any welfare issues, saving extra expense for local authorities
2. The warden highlights any sign of abuse or neglect of residents, and report to local authorities
3. The warden ensures the health and safety of communal areas within the building
4. The warden gives extra support and assistance to residents with learning difficulties, placed in the accommodation by the local authority, and whom, if left without the additional support, would leave the other residents to take on the onus. This is an unacceptable

burden to place on all concerned living within the court, in view of the specific focused requirements needed to support special needs residents

5. The warden ensures the residents have all reassurance they require related to their safety from unwanted and criminal elements within the area.

6. The warden is critical liaison between the residents and the family and medical resources in cases where additional help and assistance is required in medical and other emergencies and day to day issues.

7. The warden is an important and critical member of the community, Not only giving the residents the reassurance they need on the day to day level, but ensuring that all needs are addressed, including daily contact with the outside world, to make certain the no-one is simply left to suffer on any level in silence.
